

#### **Staffing Support Resources**

- Develop, draft, translate, and implement CERP
- Enforcement of CERP measure commitments, including increased stationary source inspections
- Develop *new* grant programs
- Coordinate air monitoring siting logistics, data analysis
- Plan and coordinate logistics for CSC meetings, subcommittees
- Ongoing analysis to review District rules, above and beyond regular District review
- Collect and validate pollutant reporting information for all stationary sources


#### **Program Services and Supplies**

- Air monitoring toxics analysis



## Examples of CSC-Driven Implementation of Priority CERP Incentive Measures

- Early priorities for implementation of incentives measures were discussed in CSC subcommittees over past year
  - -School filtration program (\$1,500,000)
  - -School buses (\$6,400,000)
  - -Truck reroute study (\$500,000)
- Subcommittee and full CSC recommended reallocation of funding from locomotives to vegetative barriers/urban greening
  - -CSC recommendation approved by Governing Board in August


