Ned's definitely not wrong in that, purely from an emission reduction standpoint, other equivalent on-road vehicles emit FAR more pollutants than school buses; there are a couple of reasons for this but the BIG one is just higher usage of other on-road vehicles. That being said, when you get into the realm of zero-emission equipment, school buses really close the gap quite a bit in terms of efficiency of emission reductions!
