


Recap of August Meeting

- SUSD officially approved the purchase of 10 electric buses to replace diesel buses running in community
- SUSD provided update on status of <u>air filtration deployment</u> and confirmed no longer need the CERP funding
 - -School Filtration: CSC voted and majority ruled to move the \$2.6M away from school air filtration
 - Residential Lawn and Garden: CSC voted and majority ruled not to pursue additional funding for residential lawn and garden at this time
 - Current funding for 50 units
 - CSC interested in discussing commercial units instead
 - Fireplace replacement: CSC voted and wanted more discussion
 - Request of District to come back with cost data




Current Fireplace Change Out in Stockton






Average Natural Gas Device Cost by Year

Energy Bill Assistance

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

- Offer income-eligible residents of San Joaquin County
- HEAP provides one payment, ranging from \$213-\$488 every calendar year

California Alternate Rates for Energy Program (CARE)

- A monthly discount of 20% or more on gas and electricity
- Participants qualify through income guidelines or if enrolled in certain public assistance programs
