
# Community Air Monitoring Update

- Xylene




## Summary of Air Monitoring Van Data November 1, 2021–December 31, 2021

PM2.5 μg/m³	18	41 (24-hr average)	35 (24-hr average)
CO ppm	0.4	2	35
NO2 ppb	17	41	100
SO2 ppb	0.5	2	75



#### PM2.5 Daily Average Comparison











#### 1-Hr Average NO2 Comparison
