Replacing gasoline powered transit vehicles is important to reduce the public's exposure to pollutants that negatively impact human health, especially for sensitive populations such as children and the elderly. Disadvantage communities often lack infrastructure to support zero-emission vehicles and the transportation needs of the community Zeo-Emission (ZE) and or Transitional Zero-Emission (TZE) transit vehicles would enable residents to continue using dial-a-ride services while also reducing emissions.

#### UPCOMING UNMET TRANSIT NEED HEARING

THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1971 (TDA) AS AMENDED PROVIDES FOR DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FROM THE LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR VARIOUS ELIGIBLE TRANSPORTATION USES. THE FUNDS ARE DISTRIBUTED BY THE KERN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (KCOG), IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY. AN ELIGIBLE CLAIMANT WISHING TO RECEIVE TDA FUNDING THROUGH KCOG MUST CONDUCT AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE TRANSIT NEEDS OF THE INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS IN THE COMMUNITY.
