

Celebrating Recent CERP Measure Milestones: Indoor Air & Weatherization

COMPLETED:

With subcommittee & CSC support, **District submitted Project Plan to CARB for approval on Dec 9**

SJ County partner attended CSC meeting to introduce **weatherization incentives & opportunities for coordinated outreach**

District Governing Board approved program in **February 2023**

District released Request for Quotation (RFQ) for air filtration device vendors in **March 2023**

NEXT STEPS: Contract with air filtration device vendor and launch program in **June 2023**

YOUR FEEDBACK REQUESTED: District will schedule subcommittee meeting ahead of program opening

Update on Lawn and Garden Measure

Replace gas powered lawn mowers with electric equipment at no cost to Stockton AB
617 community residents (up to \$500 per household)

Funding in CERP
\$20,000 for 50 mowers

Status
13 mowers to residents

Remaining Funds
\$15,850 for 37 mowers

COMPLETED:

Project plan approved by CARB **October 2022**

District issued a press release about the program, including Stockton's specific measure, on **April 2023**, generated stories via print, radio, social media, and TV across the Valley

5 new applicants since press release

YOUR FEEDBACK REQUESTED: Is there CSC interest in shifting funding to this measure, which will allow for a larger event, more concerted outreach? What other outreach efforts should we pursue?

Update on Tune In Tune Up (TITU) Vehicle Repair Measure

Repair Stockton AB 617 community resident vehicles (up to \$850) through the Tune In Tune Up (TITU) program, which holds local events at the Stockton Fairgrounds

Funding in CERP
\$300,000 extra for
community residents

Status
4 TITU events in
Stockton since 2020

June 2023 GB item to
renew contract with
Valley CAN

COMPLETED:

Project plan reviewed by CARB and resubmitted for approval **April 2023**

NEXT STEPS: With CARB approval, work with Valley Clean Air Now (Valley CAN) to use additional funding specifically for vehicle repairs for residents living in Stockton Boundary over next 3 years

Residential Vehicle Replacement Measure

Replace Stockton AB 617 community resident gas-powered vehicles (**up to \$12,000**) with plug-in hybrid or electric vehicles

Funding in CERP
\$800,000 for up to 65
vehicles

COMPLETED:

Project plan submitted for approval **April 2023**



YOUR FEEDBACK REQUESTED: In the past, Valley CAN has held community education events to introduce folks to these newer vehicles and help them apply to the program. Is the CSC interested in launching these in the community? Other outreach opportunities?

Urban Greening & Vegetative Barriers Measure

Plant trees and install vegetative barriers around sources of concern to block pollution

Funding in CERP

\$1M for Urban Greening
\$ 1M for Vegetative Barriers

COMPLETED:

Request for Proposals closed in November 2022, subcommittee reviewing proposals

NEXT STEPS: Applicant updated and sent proposals to District (to respond to subcommittee and District feedback). Once received, District will review, send materials to subcommittee, and schedule next meeting

YOUR FEEDBACK REQUESTED: If subcommittee supports final proposals, we will bring back to CSC for full approval
