AB 617 Funding Categories Work Together





CAP Incentive Funds

The Community Air Protection Incentives Guidelines* specify that incentive funds can be used for both *mobile* and *stationary source* projects.





Community Air Protection Incentives 2019 Guidelines

Approved by the Board: May 23, 2019

Revised October 14, 2020

Two Types of Projects:

- 1. Established projects, which allow for streamlined implementation (Chapters 4 and 5)
- 2. New project ideas, known as Community-Identified Projects that use incentive mechanisms (Chapter 6)





Incentive Allocation Principles*

- 1. Legislative precedent from year one.
- 2. AB 617 communities with CERPs and/or CAMPs per Air District.
- 3. Other communities that could be selected in future years.
- 4. Opportunity to implement projects in smaller Air Districts.
- 5. Per CARB Board, at least 70% of the incentive funds must be spent in disadvantaged communities and at least 80% spent in a combination of disadvantaged or low-income communities.

As a result, the primary consideration for the allocation of funds is the number of disadvantaged communities in each Air District.

Implementation Funds

Implementation funds support administrative functions and duties related to implementation of AB 617



Implementation funds support both:

- 1. CARB
- 2. Air District

Air districts submit annual reports to CARB summarizing the fund expenditures









Implementation Funds by Air District



Community Air Grants Funding

CAGs fund community-based organizations to help identify, evaluate, and reduce air pollutant exposure and emissions and builds capacity to participate in the AB 617 process



Funds Allow Communities to . . .

- Hire consultants and/or technical experts
- Reach out and engage stakeholders
- Design and operate community air monitors
- Collect and analyze data, including communitybased participatory research projects





Community Air Grants in SJV

- 56 grants Statewide, worth \$15 million
- 14 Grants in SJV, worth \$3.12 million
- 13 SJV community organizations
- SJV Grant Types:6 technical, 8 educational
