

Shafter Community Enforcement UpdateFirst Quarter 2023

Covering enforcement activities in the community from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2023:

Residential Wood Burning – District Rule 4901

- District requirements in effect from Nov. 1 Feb. 28/29 each year
- CERP commitment: Enhanced enforcement (four hours of enforcement on each wood burning curtailment day)
- 2 public complaints received
- 3 violation notices issued

Illegal Open Burning - District Rule 4103

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort every quarter
- 2 public complaints received
- 2 violation notices issued

Statewide Anti-Idling Enforcement

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort every quarter
- No violations of CARB's truck and bus regulation observed

Stationary Source Inspections

- CERP commitment: Increased inspection frequency at facilities with emission violations in the last 3 years
- 38 total stationary source inspections
- 2 violation notices issued (0 procedural/administrative, 2 emissions related)

Public Complaints

- 5 total public complaints responded to in the community
 - 1 fugitive dust
 - o 2 smoking chimneys
 - o 2 odor
- 1 violation notice issued
