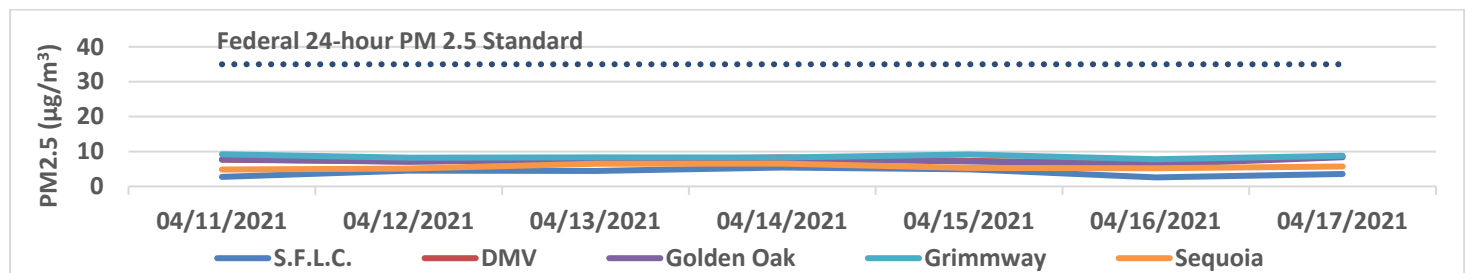
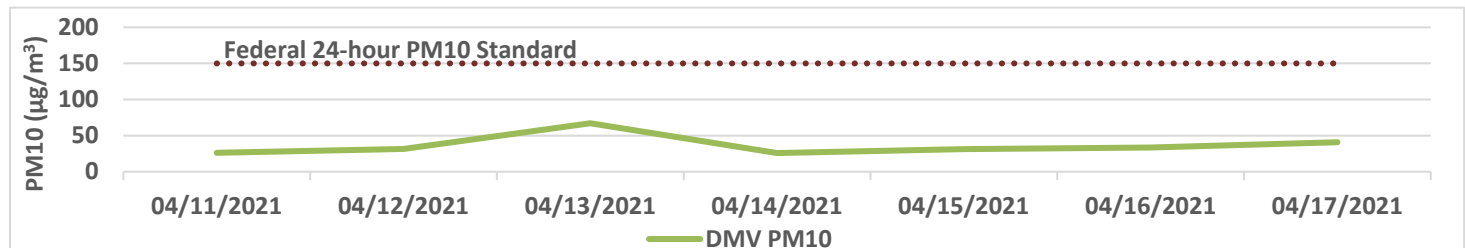

Ongoing Implementation

» * Based on CSC recommendation, the District explored installing air monitoring at La Gardenia restaurant. District staff found limited access to the roof and also very limited space on the ground with access to electricity. The District has also been working with the County to install air monitoring equipment at an empty lot on the northwest corner of Martinez St and Paseo De Pico St. The County will be installing a basketball court and picnic tables in this area. The District will be working with the County to determine the best location for the equipment based on the design of the development.
