Heavy-Duty Truck Measure Discussion



Heavy-Duty Truck Replacement Measure

Replace heavy-duty trucks with zero emission trucks at businesses located within AB 617

Stockton boundary

Funding in CERP \$10 Million

Status0 trucks replaced

<u>Discussion in Heavy-Duty Trucks Subcommittee & CSC:</u>

- Challenges for local businesses/single owner-operators to take advantage of program, outreach opportunities to local businesses to participate in program
- May 2023 subcommittee: discussed San Diego APCD Zero-Emission Truck Pilot Program → next steps: bring draft outline of potential project plan changes for CSC consideration
- August CSC meeting: discussed proposed project plan with new pathway
- Today: seek CSC support to submit project plan to CARB



Proposed Aspects of Project Plan for Submittal

Allow fleet owners within the Valley's Stockton AB 617 boundary to **expand their fleets** by purchasing new zero-emission trucks without the need to scrap existing, compliant vehicles

Increased funding amount allowed per vehicle replacement


Requirements for trips made in Stockton AB 617 boundary

<u>Updates based on CSC feedback</u>: Reporting requirements for miles driven by displaced diesel trucks



Opportunity for New Pathway for HD Truck Measure

In addition to existing/traditional heavy-duty truck measure, we are proposing to submit a **project plan** to CARB to add a **new pathway** to allow for local businesses/single-owner operators to expand their fleet with zero emission trucks (no funding reallocation)

Passenger Vehicle Repair & Replace Measures Updates

- Project Plans for Passenger Vehicle Repair and Replace programs <u>approved</u> by CARB
 - Passenger Vehicle Repair Measure: Funding for vehicle emissions related repairs for high polluting vehicles operating in the Stockton AB 617 community Funding allocation: \$300,000
 - Passenger Vehicle Replace Measure: Funding for replacement of passenger vehicles with battery electric or plug-in hybrid vehicles
 - Funding allocation: \$800,000, up to 100 vehicles

Next steps:

- September: District Governing Board approval
- October: Work with CSC on program outreach and implementation
- Today: Discuss opportunity to increase funding amount for Vehicle Replacement Measure

	USED: Plug-in hybrid electric of zero-emission vehicle purchase	\$11,500	\$12,000
