



NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP AB 617 Community Emission Reduction Program Development

The District invites you to attend a public workshop to present, discuss, and receive feedback on the development of community-specific emission reduction programs in the communities of Shafter and South Central Fresno at **5:30 PM on Wednesday, August 28, 2019**.

This workshop is the latest in the District's robust public engagement process to implement Assembly Bill (AB) 617 (C. Garcia, Chapter 136, Statutes of 2017) and further develop a comprehensive community engagement and protection program in the Valley. Shafter and South Central Fresno were selected by the California Air Resources Board to receive clean air resources available through AB 617 legislation, including the development of local community air monitoring plans and community-specific emissions reduction programs. The initial draft plans to reduce emissions in these communities have been released for public review and comment at the following website: http://community.valleyair.org. The final Community Emission Reduction Program for each community will be presented for approval at the District Governing Board meeting on September 19, 2019.
