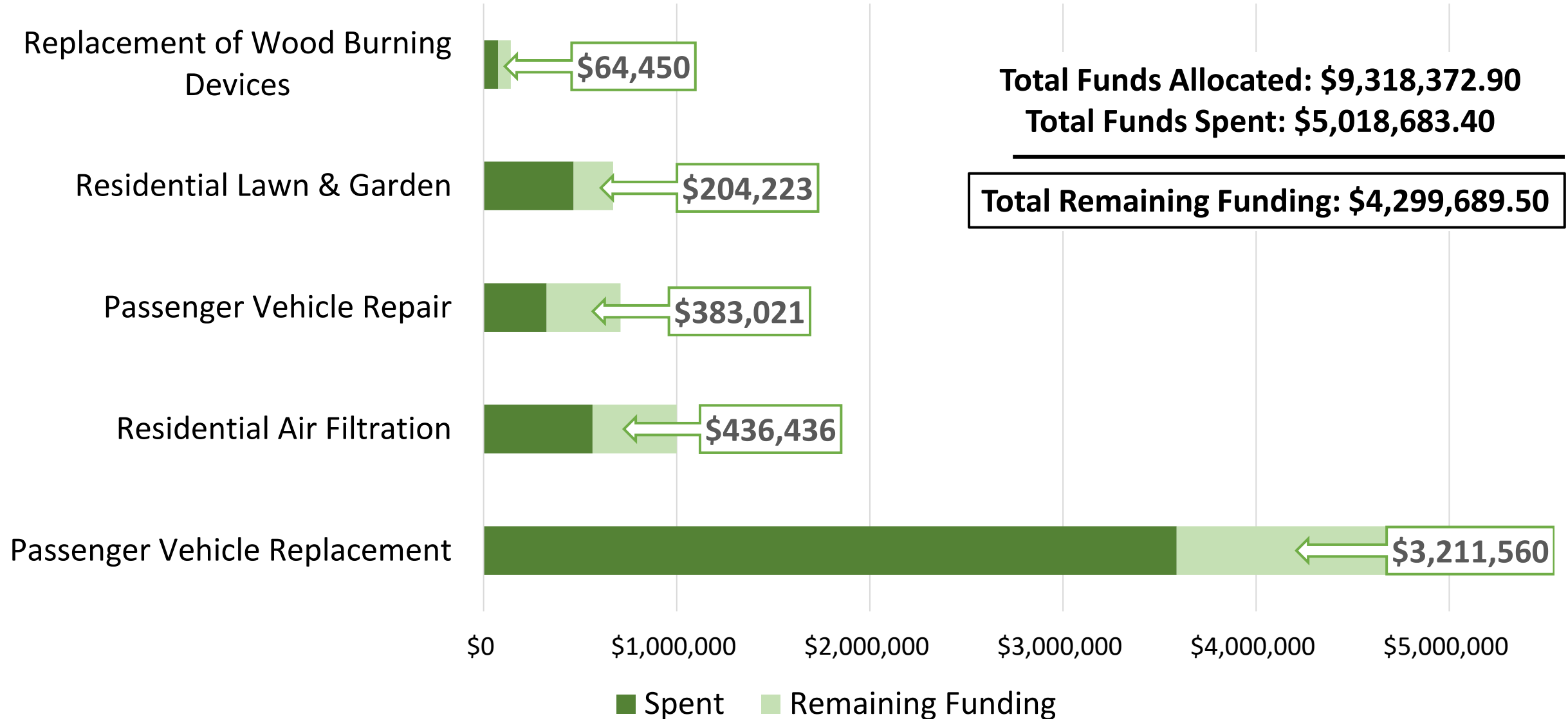

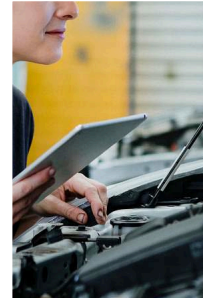

# Stockton Lawnmower Trade-In + TITU Events



Held 3 events since 2024

- Nearly 1,000 mowers exchanged
- 860 vehicles participated in TITU

# Clean Air Rooms Program

- District will continue outreach (schools, social media, in-person events)
- Working on CAR program expansion with CARB and District Grants team
  - Sensitive receptors (childcare centers, nursing homes, elderly care facilities, etc.)
  - Two purifiers per household
- Will notify CSC when program changes are available

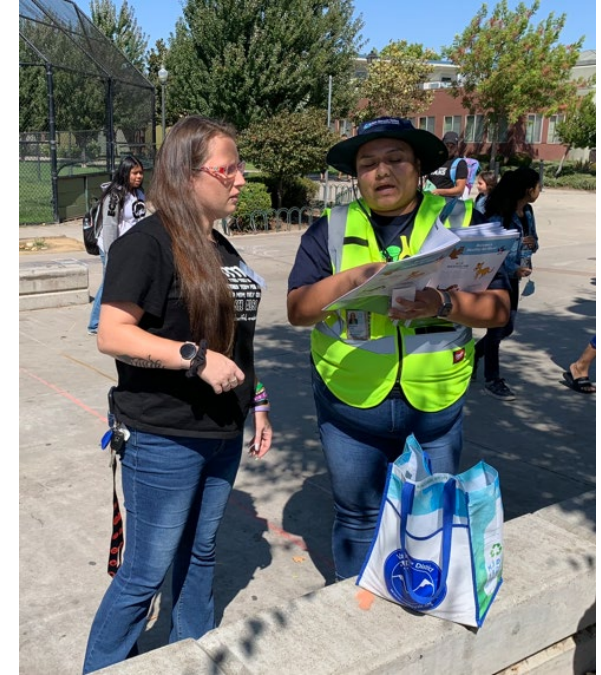
