# Clean Air Rooms Update

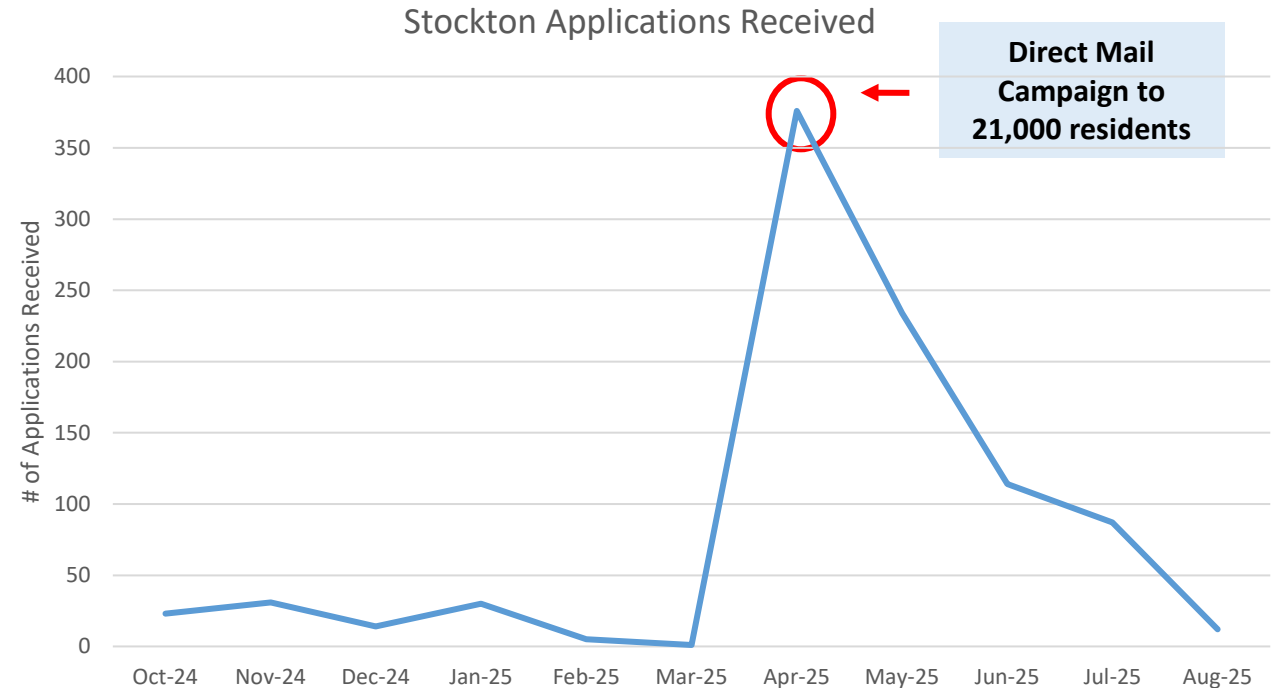

- Since program opened, District has worked with CSC and CBOs to conduct outreach and plan/attend events to sign residents up for program
  - Social media posts, direct outreach to schools, community centers and other community hubs, coordination with CBOs, mailout campaign
  - Attended 40 events to sign residents up for program

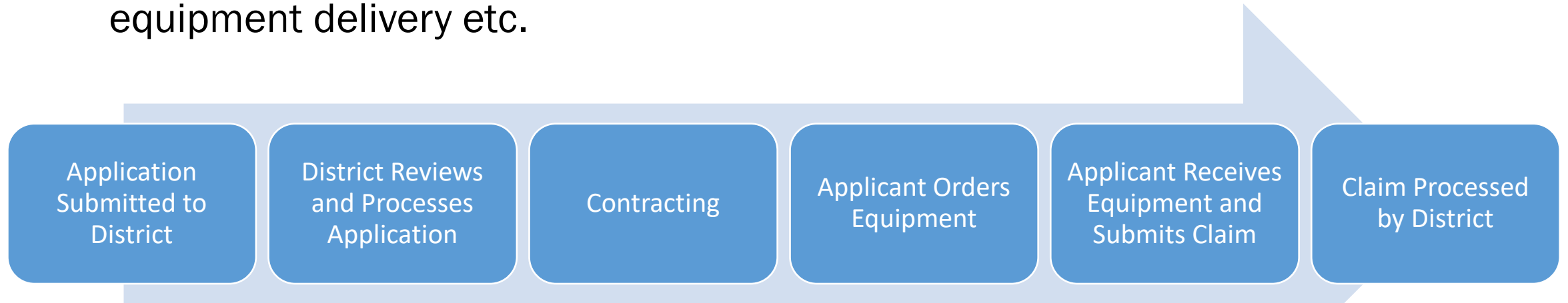


# Clean Air Rooms Program Expansion

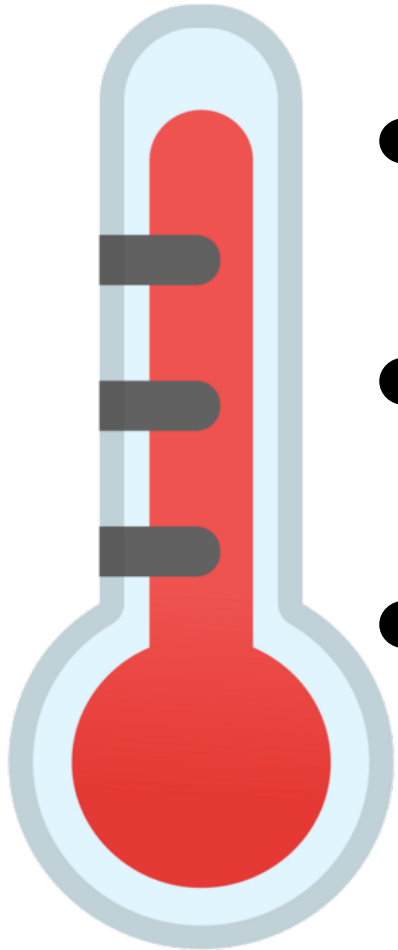
- Shafter CSC proposed expanding CAR program to include other sensitive receptors, such as senior centers, and Fresno CSC supported expansion in their CERP
- Given **demonstrated need and alignment with CARB's incentive guidelines** for improving indoor air quality, the District expanding CAR Program in Shafter and Fresno proposes same expansion in Stockton
  - Expand to: **daycares, childcare centers, senior living centers, nursing homes and additional spaces that serve sensitive receptors**
  - Commercial sized units, depending on size of facility
  - Up to 25% of funding (\$250,000) allocated to effort
  - District will bring updates to CSC and adjust as needed
- *District will continue outreach for residential/in-home purifiers*

# Project Timeframes

- Given 5 year CERP timeframe (July 2026), it's important for CSC to continue making strategic decisions so funding is promptly spent on clean air strategies in the community
  - Based on experience with Year 1 Communities of Shafter and Fresno, expect residential measures with shorter processing times to continue into Year 6
  - Want to make program changes and contract heavy-duty projects by early 2026 to allow for administrative updates, contracting, purchase equipment, equipment delivery etc.
