



Shafter Community Enforcement Update

First Quarter 2025

Covering enforcement activities in the community from 1/1/2025 through 3/31/2025:

Residential Wood Burning – District Rule 4901

- District requirements in effect from Nov. 1 – Feb. 28/29 each year
- CERP commitment: Enhanced enforcement (four hours of enforcement on each wood burning curtailment day)
- No public complaints received
- 6 violation notices issued

Illegal Open Burning – District Rule 4103

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort every quarter
- 4 public complaints received
- 1 violation notice issued

Statewide Anti-Idling Enforcement

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort every quarter
- No violations of CARB's truck and bus regulation observed

Stationary Source Inspections

- CERP commitment: Increased inspection frequency at facilities with emission violations in the last 3 years
- 48 total stationary source inspections (46 compliance inspections, 1 source test observation, 1 breakdown/deviation inspection)

Enforcement Action Summary

- Stationary Source: 11 violation notices issued (8 emissions related, 3 procedural/administrative)
- Non-stationary Source: 10 violation notice issued (8 emissions related, 2 procedural/administrative)

Public Complaints

- 4 total public complaint responded to in the community
 - 2 agricultural burns
 - 2 open burns
- 1 violation notice issued
