

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP

Year 2 Selection of AB 617 Communities in the San Joaquin Valley

The District invites you to attend a public workshop to present, discuss, and receive feedback on the upcoming selection process for San Joaquin Valley communities recommended for additional clean air resources under Assembly Bill (AB) 617 (C. Garcia, Chapter 136, Statutes of 2017) at **5:30 PM on Thursday, August 29, 2019**.

The District is seeking public feedback on the prioritization of disadvantaged communities in the Valley for investment in community-level air pollution reduction efforts, under the second year of implementation of AB 617. This public input will be used to inform the District's recommendations to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) for communities to be selected for local air pollution monitoring and/or implementation of community-specific emission reduction programs under AB 617. District staff will present proposed community recommendations for District Governing Board approval at the September 19, 2019, public hearing, prior to forwarding these community recommendations to CARB for consideration.
