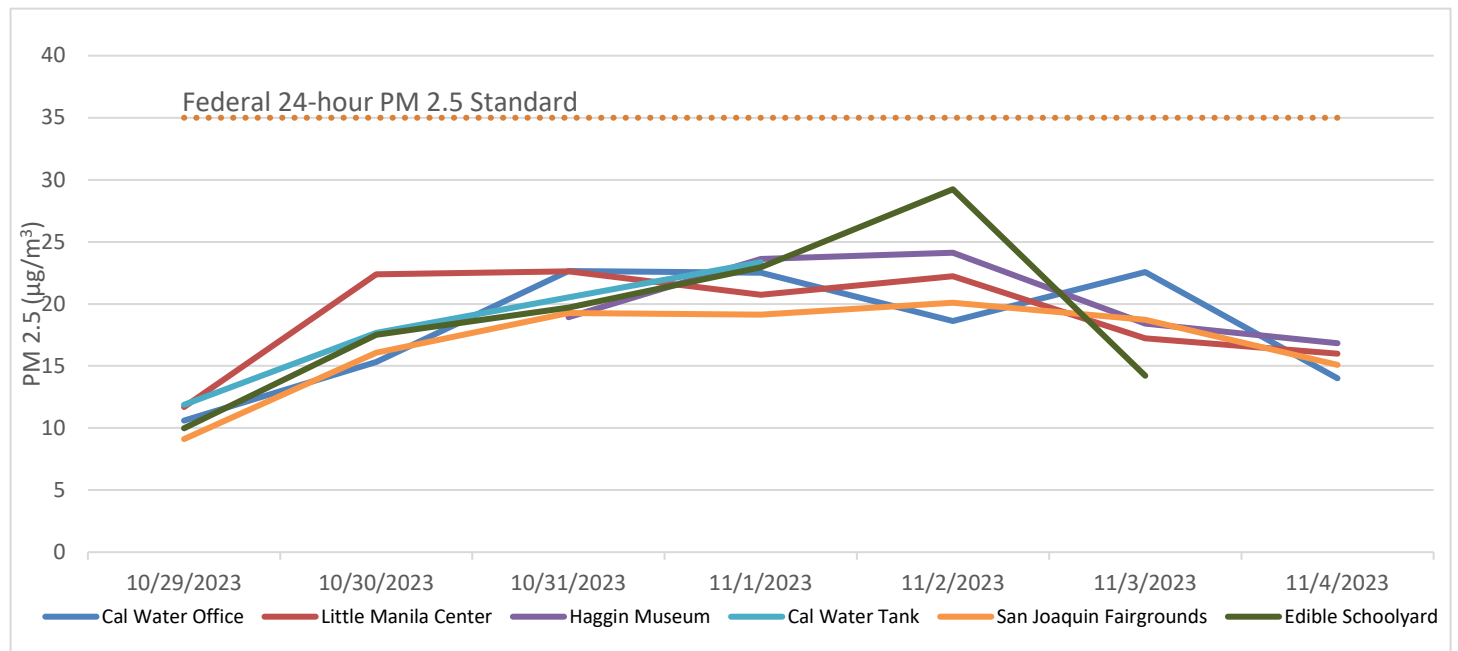

PM2.5 Monitoring:



*PM2.5 at Haggin Museum was down due to annual instrument calibration from 10/29 – 10/31

*PM2.5 at Cal Water Tank was down due to annual instrument calibration from 11/2 – 11/4

*PM2.5 at Edible Schoolyard was down on 11/4 due to an instrument error

Understanding Toxics and Particulate Matter:
