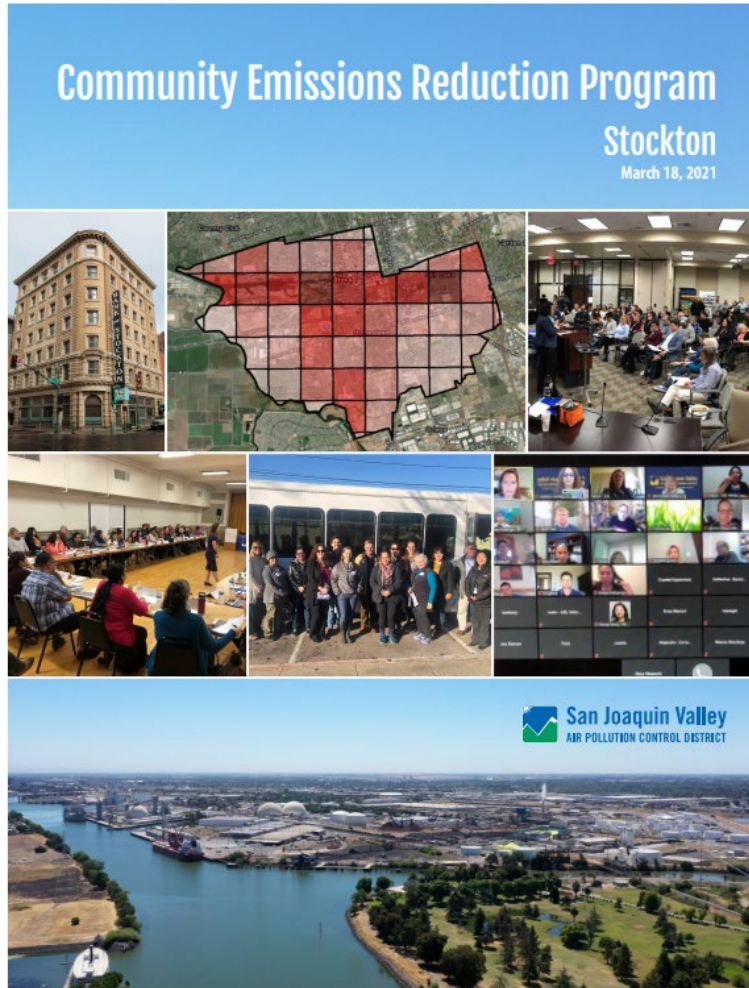

# Bike Lane CERP Measure



**What is the goal of this CERP measure?**

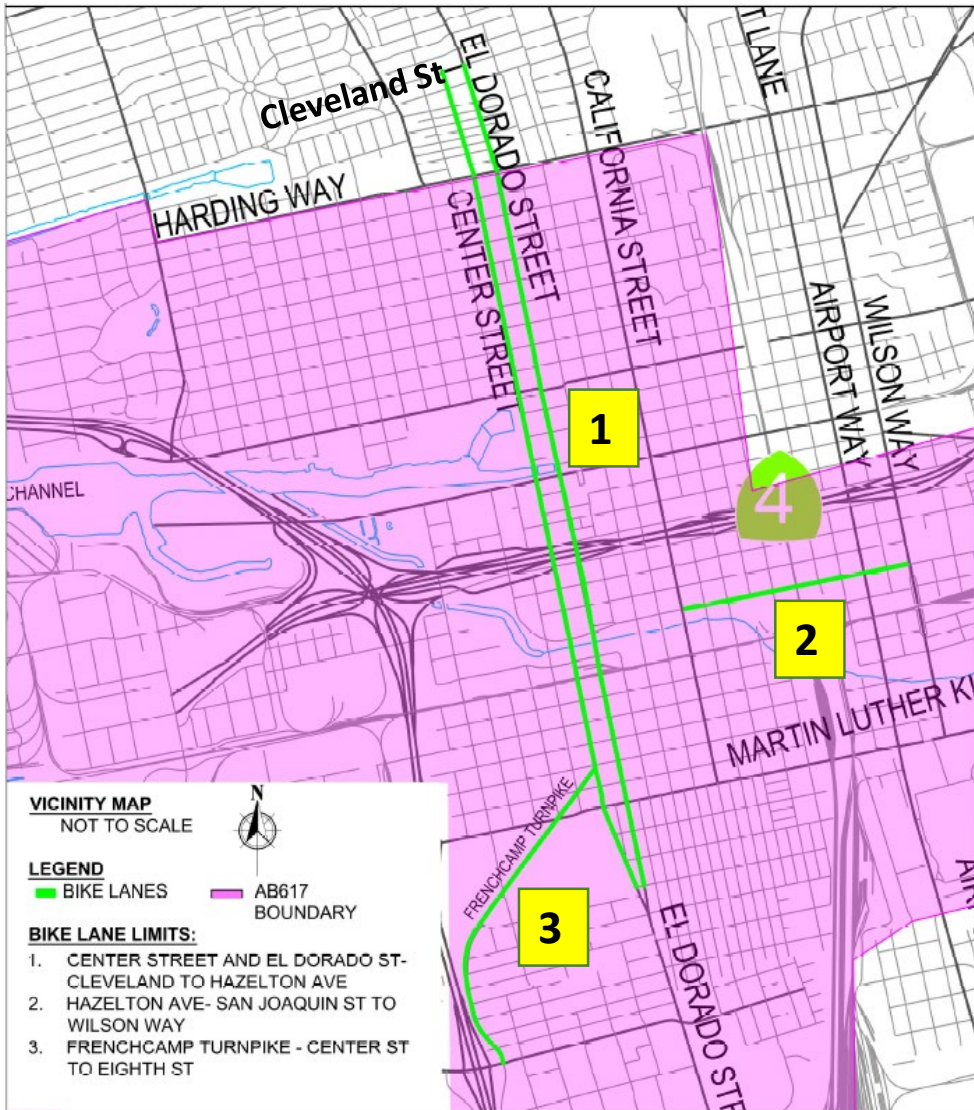
To work with transportation agencies in the Stockton area and seek to assist these agencies to help identify and leverage funding and make the community more bike friendly

Funding will be used on bike lane installation, which includes things like paving and striping, to reduce emissions and “vehicle miles traveled”

# City of Stockton Bike Lane Project Summary

- **Project Name:** Stockton Safe Routes to School Safety and Connectivity Improvements Project
- **Allocated AB 617 Funding:** \$500,000
- **Project Description:** Funding for installation of bike lanes near several elementary, middle and high schools to increase safety and active modes of transportation
- **Opportunity with Bike Path CERP Measure:** Leveraging funds to support City of Stockton project, which aims to increase safety and active transportation through construction of bike lanes, missing sidewalk, curb ramps and safety features (installing high visibility crosswalks with flashing beacons) in disadvantaged communities

# Bike Lane Project Budget



- Overall Budget for Bike lane installation:
  - Center and El Dorado Estimate (Site 1): \$1,977,102.50
  - Hazelton Ave (Site 2): \$813,385.00
  - French Camp Turn Pike (Site 3): \$282,922.50
- \$500K from CERP will go towards bike lane installation, including removal and installation of striping, crack, and slurry sealing at sites in AB 617 boundary

# Opportunities for Funding Reallocation

- Based on June 2022 CSC support, CSC no longer pursuing School Air Filtration measure
  - \$2,640,000 was removed from measure
  - \$115,000 was shifted to support residential wood burning
  - \$100,000 was shifted to support residential lawn and garden
  - \$386,627 was shifted to support commercial lawn and garden
  - \$2,000,000 was shifted to support passenger vehicle replace
- As we understand demand for programs, District is committed to working with CSC to reallocate funds to measures as needed
  - To make reallocation to in need measures possible, District will also work with CSC to identify measures that

# CERP Measure Implementation – Locomotives Update

Measure & Description	Funding Allocated & Progress to Date	Next Steps
Diesel Switcher Locomotives	\$6,800,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="1309 382 2499 554">• April 2023 regulation in effect, limits time agencies can provide funding for replacement with state dollars</li></ul> <p data-bbox="1309 634 2499 809"><b>Next steps:</b> District seeking federal grants to allow for maximum funding to replace locomotives and will pursue opportunities to leverage state funding</p>

Although the District is still seeking opportunities with this measure, the District recommends beginning to reallocate some funds to support other in need, priority measures.

# Opportunities for Funding Re-allocation: Residential Lawn and Garden

Replace gas powered lawn mowers with electric equipment at no cost to Stockton AB  
617 community residents (up to \$500 per household)

**Funding in CERP**  
\$120,000 for 250  
mowers

**Status**  
204 mowers to residents

**Remaining Funds**  
\$42,177 for 84 mowers

Residential Lawn and Garden  
Measure

Yes: Add \$200,000 to Residential Lawn &  
Garden

400 mowers added  
Hold 2 large event in community

NO: Do Not Add \$200,000 to Residential  
Lawn & Garden

No change, continue to fund the remaining  
37 mowers
