About the Meeting Structure

- Continue hosting Subcommittee Meetings with the support of Air Districts and potentially facilitators.
- Ensure the content from Subcommittee Meetings is brought back to monthly CSC meetings.
- Facilitators must be committed to hosting meetings with transparency and always checking for understanding (i.e., making sure that everyone has a shared understanding of terminology and shared next steps so that people are on the same page before moving forward.)
- CSC members can email the facilitator group with questions at any point.
- Continue to use inclusive methods of engagement that allow for all CSC members to be recognized and acknowledged during meetings.

Annual Report

- Community residents would like to ensure revisions are incorporated into the final Annual Report.
- Notification portion of CERP requires more implementation and enforcement.
- For the next draft of the annual report, Air District will include tracking on progress of the 51 measures (e.g., breakdown of the amount of dollars invested and reduction, some historical data points).
- CARB is committed to continue to make progress on implementation of AB617 and encourages CSC engagement.

Air District

- The Air District is giving away free mowers. The Air District will be printing flyers to advertise, will be hosting paid social media, Shafter Press, NextDoor app, and snail mail flyers, weekly Shafter newsletter.
- CSC will notify the Air District if more flyers are needed.
- Air District created a generic website for RSVP.
- Air District is looking for partners to host a food booth.
- Resident incentive programs (e.g., lawn mowers, fireplace, etc.) plans are being reviewed by CARB and Air district. Updates will be provided once programs are approved.
- Kern County is still in process approving the placement of air monitors because the electrical infrastructure needs to be built. If you have a recommendation for placement of air monitor, please contact chay.thao@valleyair.org
