



Stockton Enforcement Update

Second Quarter 2025

Covering enforcement activities in the community from 4/1/25 through 6/30/25:

Fugitive Dust – District Regulation VIII

- CERP Commitment: One targeted enforcement effort during the 2nd and 3rd quarters, which tend to be the driest times of the year and most likely to have issues with fugitive dust from earthmoving activities
- 6 construction project sites inspected for compliance with District and state regulations
- 1 fugitive dust complaint received

Statewide Anti-Idling Enforcement

- CERP Commitment: One targeted enforcement effort during each quarter
- No public complaints of idling diesel trucks received
- No violations of CARB's anti-idling regulation were issued during District enforcement

Stationary Source Inspections

- CERP commitment: Increased inspection frequency at facilities which receive an emissions violation
- 45 total stationary source inspections
(43 compliance inspections & 2 source test observations)

Enforcement Action Summary

- Stationary Source: 4 violation notices issued (1 procedural/administrative, 3 emissions related)
- Non-stationary Source: 2 violation notices issued

Public Complaints

- 11 public complaints responded to in the community
(7 open burn, 1 fugitive dust, 1 unregulated, 2 others referred)
