Heavy-Duty Truck Replacement Status

- **Original Funding in CERP:** \$10,000,000
- During March CSC meeting, CSC supported reallocating \$4,000,000 to the passenger vehicle replacement measure to support residents in replacing their older, high polluting vehicle with a cleaner option
- **New Funding Amount:** \$6,000,000
- While District continuing outreach on this measure, many challenges faced by businesses making the transition to electric trucks
 - Cost
 - Infrastructure
 - Technology
 - Regulatory concerns

Heavy-Duty Truck Replacement Outreach Efforts

- District will continue working with public agencies and local businesses to conduct outreach on truck replacement program
- District also continuing to attend trucking outreach events to speak to businesses, manufacturers and other stakeholders

Heavy-duty Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure

- **Funding in CERP:** \$1,000,000
- District worked with Sunrise Sanitation (Republic Services) to install charging infrastructure
- During April in-person meeting, CSC suggested seeking additional partners to install charging infrastructure, so District is conducting additional outreach
- If CSC is aware of any companies looking to electrify their fleet, please share with us!



Railcar Movers/Switchers

- **Funding in CERP:** \$6,800,000
- In September 2024, CSC supported reallocating \$200K to residential lawn and garden measure to support additional replacements and mower exchange event
- April 2023 Locomotive Regulation limited time/amount agencies could provide funding for replacement of units, CARB revisiting regulation in June 2025, which will likely change funding amounts District can offer to businesses seeking to replace units
- District continues seeking opportunities with measure, but as needed, will work with CSC to reallocation funds to other in-demand CERP measures

Clean Air Room Outreach Update

- Based on CSC feedback, the District worked with an advertising agency to send a targeted mailer to over 21,000 households within the AB617 boundary in April
 - Only in zip codes fully within the boundary
 - Targeted Clean Air Room outreach also conducted in South Central Fresno and Shafter
- District saw an increase in calls and assisted residents with applications via phone, email, and in-person
- 490 applications received in the last 30 days

Mower Exchange Event Update

- First event- May 2024
 - 155 mowers distributed
- Next event- June 28th at the San Joaquin County Fairgrounds
- Over 550 applications received in 10 days
 - Due to overwhelming demand, the application portal is now closed
 - This will use up remaining funding in CERP
