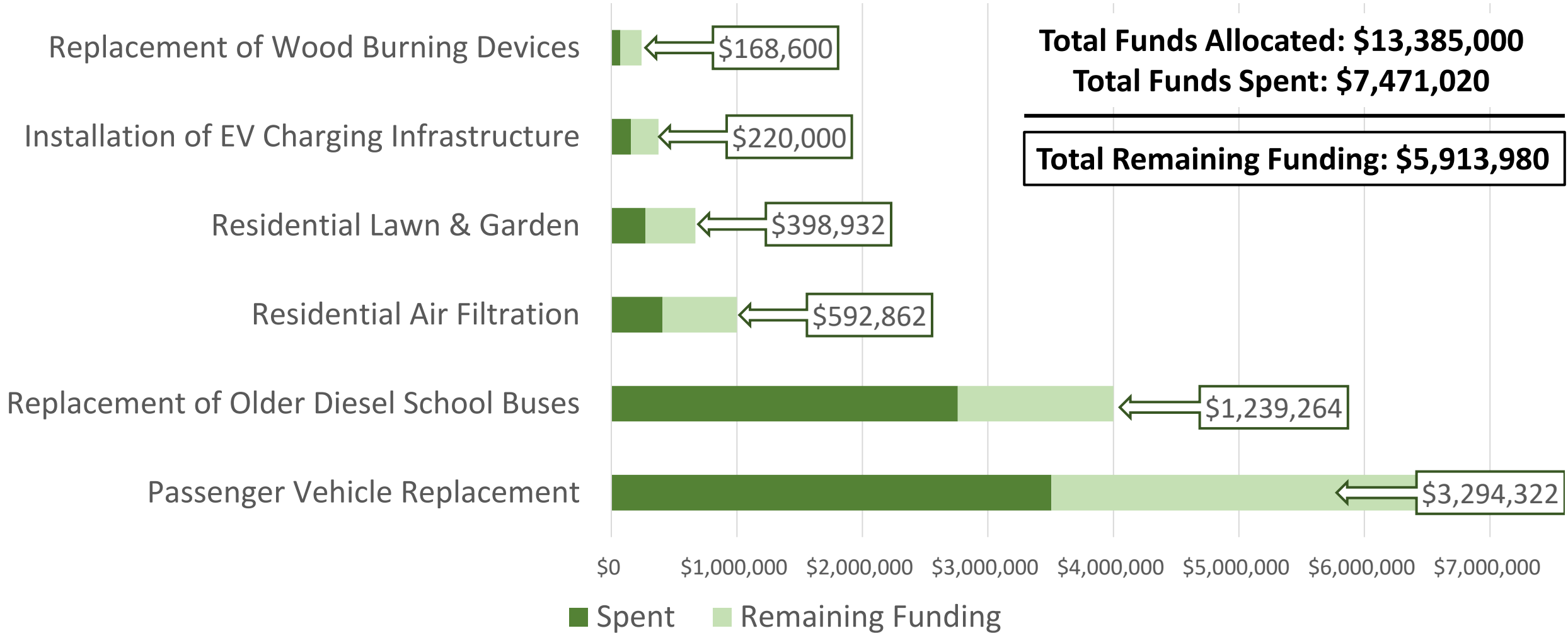

Lawnmower Trade-in + Tune-In Tune-Up Event

- District and Valley CAN hosted event on **Saturday, March 21st** at the San Joaquin County Fairgrounds
 - **366** Stockton residents exchanged their old polluting gas-powered lawnmower for a new free zero-emission, electric Stihl lawnmower
 - **410** vehicles participated in the Tune-In Tune-Up smog repair event
 - **70** residents signed up for a free residential air purifier through the Clean Air Rooms program



Remaining CERP Measures Implementation Progress



Replacement of Woodburning Devices

- Funding in the CERP: \$240,000
- Progress: \$71,400 (17 units)
- Ongoing outreach activities within the community
 - Work with network of retailers (i.e. Show-and-Tell event)
 - Social media
 - Outreach at all events District attends

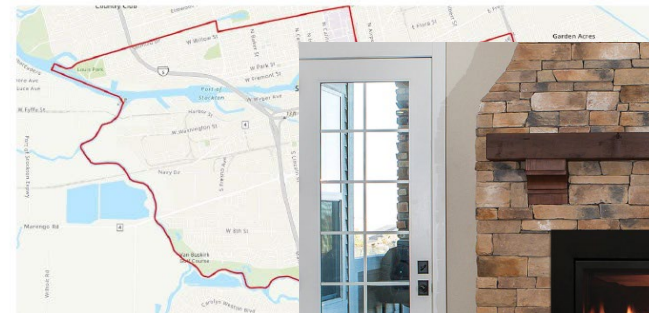

Replacement of Older Diesel School Buses

- Funding in the CERP: \$4,000,000
- Progress: \$2,760,736 (10 buses)
- Stockton Unified School District currently has 63 electric buses, including 10 funded through AB 617
- At this time, SUSD needs additional infrastructure before more buses can be secured
 - Opportunity to support School Bus chargers at Stockton Unified

Tune-In Tune-Up

- Funding in the CERP: \$300,000
- Progress: \$300,000 (funding exhausted)
- Residents receive a free emissions test to check vehicle for smog or emissions related issues and a repair voucher up to \$850 redeemable at a local STAR-certified smog shop.
- Program closed- need additional funding to continue program
 - Opportunity to shift \$220K from EV Charging Infrastructure measure and \$38K from School Air Filtration to support program

- Funding in the CERP: \$375,000
- Progress: \$155,000 (27 units)
- Continuing outreach, but seeing low interest
- Opportunity to shift funds to support Tune-In Tune-Up (Vehicle Repair) program

Residential Air Filtration

- Funding in the CERP: \$1,000,000
- Progress: \$407,137 (2,085 units)
- District working with an advertising agency to send out a second targeted mailer to households within the AB 617 boundary. Huge thanks to the CSC for the feedback on the postcard!

Opportunities with Clean Air Rooms Program

- As previously discussed, District working to expand CAR program to include daycares, senior centers and additional spaces that serve sensitive receptors
 - Up to 25%, \$250K saved for this effort
- Several AB 617 communities have discussed and supported expanding CAR program to allow for residents to obtain 2 purifiers
 - No reallocation needed
 - Program expansion



Decisions for Next Meeting

Reallocate funding to continue Tune-In Tune-Up (vehicle repair) program

Expand Clean Air Rooms program to allow 2 air purifiers per household (currently one per household)

Reallocate School Bus funding to support heavy duty infrastructure

Next Steps / Looking Ahead

- CSC has worked with District to make lots of progress moving CERP measures forward
 - Project plan, request for proposal (RFP) development
 - Necessary funding reallocations to support in need CERP measures
 - Program expansions to help expediate funds getting out into the community for clean air benefits
- With last few months of strategic decisions from CSC, overall progress is on track, with CERP measures moving forward as expected
 - District will continue to track and communicate CERP progress to CSC, including bringing any necessary funding reallocations

Transitioning CERP Measures after the 5th Year

- Based on the state law, CERP is a 5 year plan
 - Adopted by CARB in July 2021, reach 5th year in July 2026
 - District will continue to work closely with CSC on remaining CERP commitments, especially as adjustments are needed
- CERP & CAMP reporting will continue
 - Monitoring will continue as usual
 - District will continue updating CERP tracker and providing quarterly enforcement and air monitoring reports
- Transition to quarterly CSC meetings
 - Will check in on remaining CERP commitments
 - Stipends for resident members will continue
