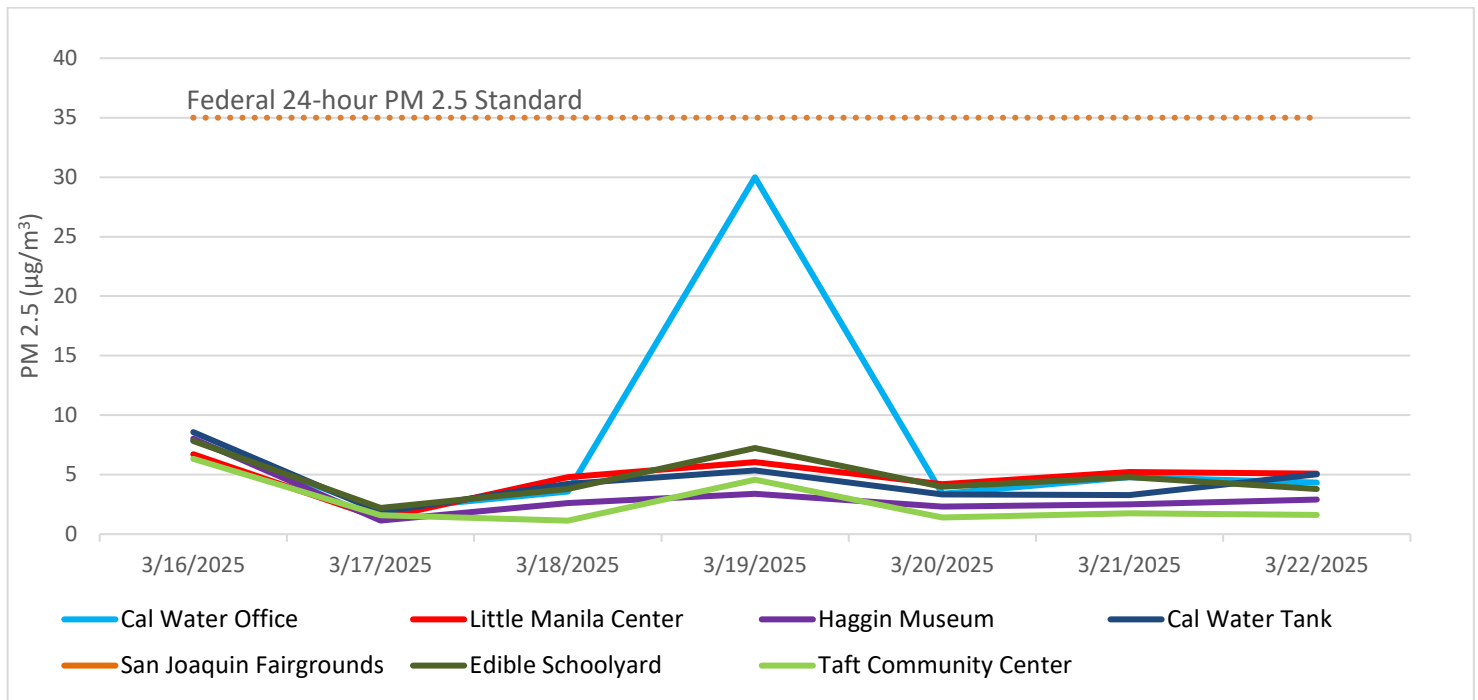

PM2.5 Monitoring



*There is currently a power outage at Stockton Fairgrounds with an unknown timeframe for the power to be restored.

On 3/19/25 an incident occurred at the Cal Water Office causing PM2.5 to spike up to 451 µg/m³ at 5 am. All information indicates that this was an isolated event in the area.

Understanding Toxics and Particulate Matter:

24-hour samples for PM2.5 and VOC toxics speciation were taken on March 19th and 21st.
