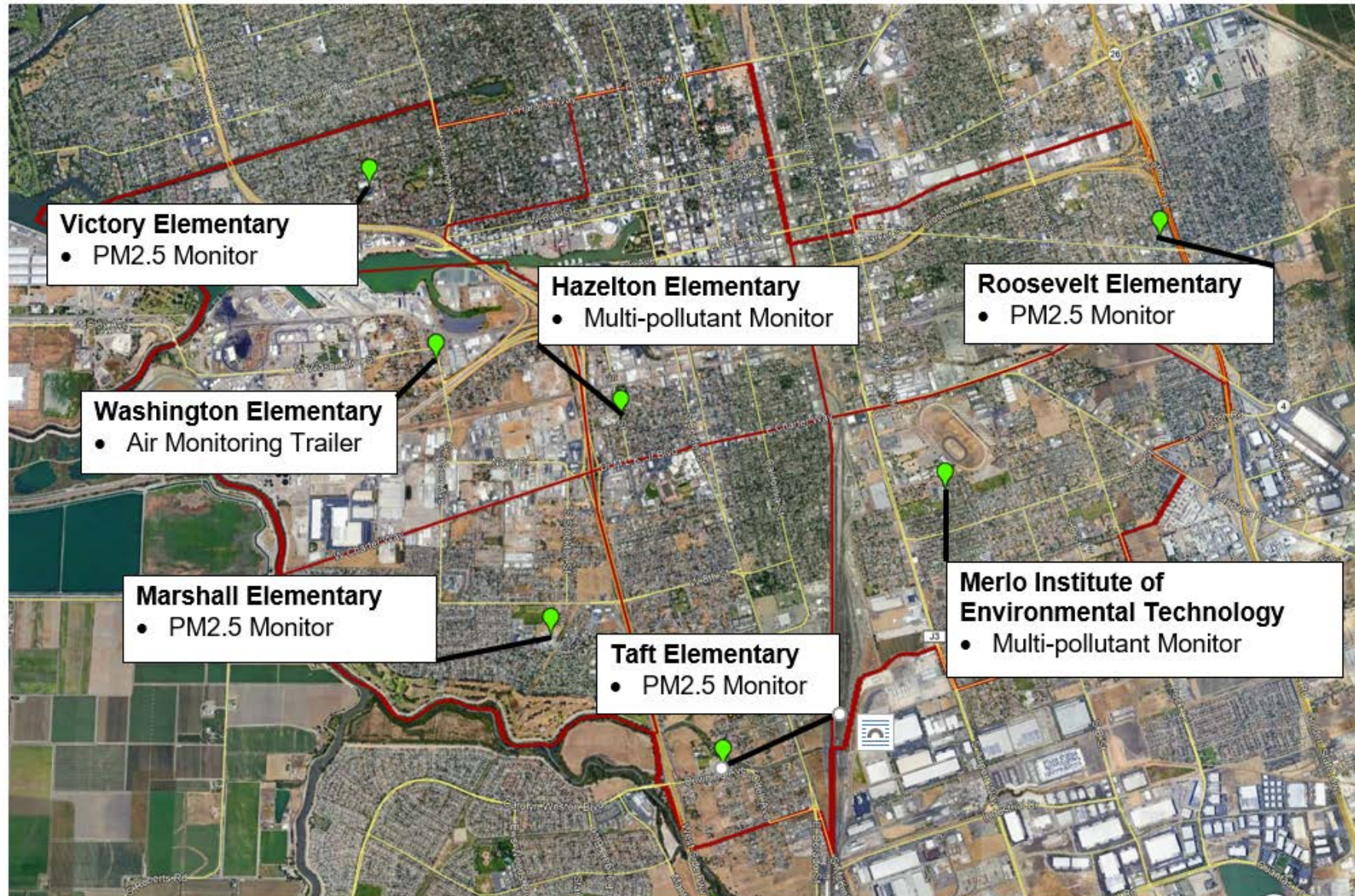

# Development of Stockton Community Air Monitoring Network

- Started process in January of 2020, working closely with Community Steering Committee (CSC)
- Identified sources of concern and associated pollutants and received recommendations from CSC on locations for air monitoring
- CSC recommended specific schools sites throughout the project boundary
- Through several meetings, developed the community air monitoring plan, including recommended air monitoring locations and types of air monitoring equipment

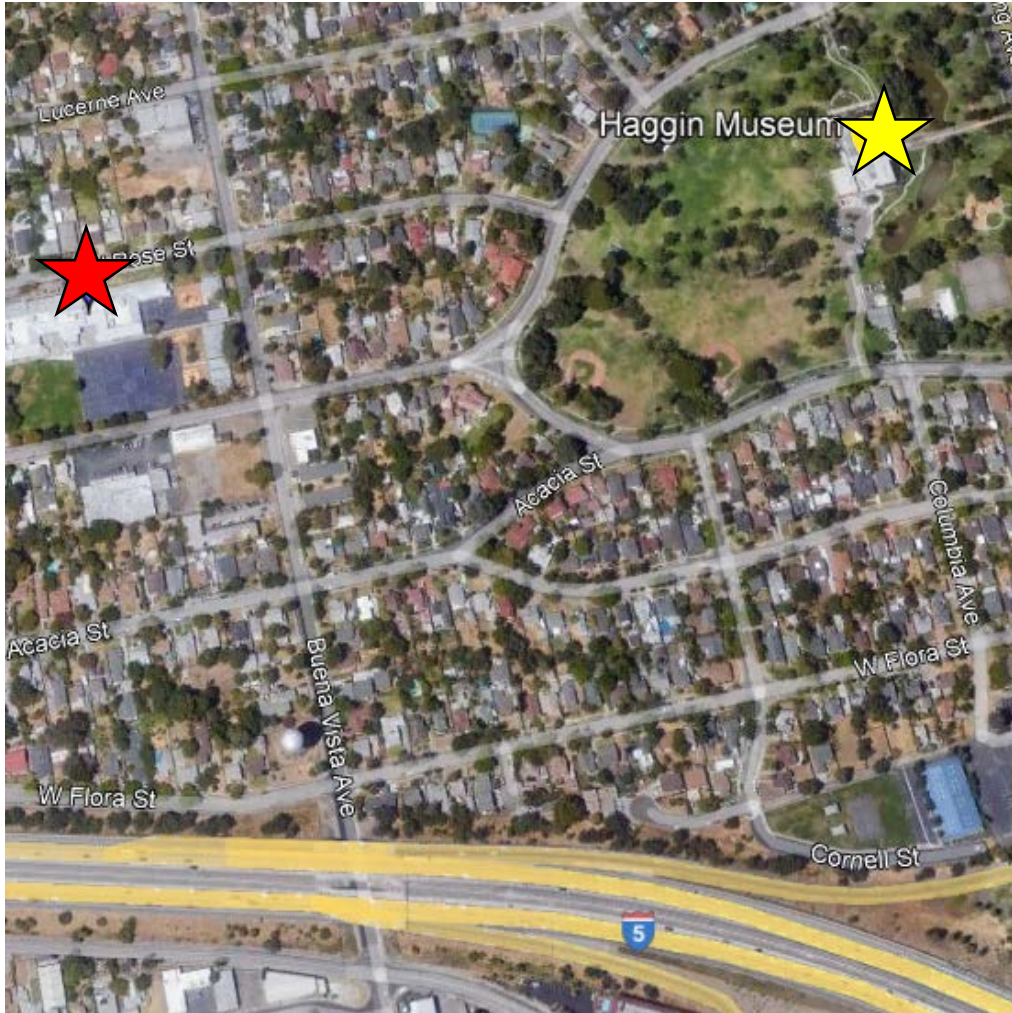




# Air Monitoring Efforts with Stockton Unified School District

- Air District staff worked closely with staff from Stockton Unified School District (SUSD) to determine possible air monitor locations and developed a license agreement that allows for the installation and operation of the air monitoring
- Specific locations identified in license agreement have been reviewed in person by both SUSD and Air District staff to ensure proper operating conditions and safety
- Per license agreement, Air District will cover cost of installation, any required infrastructure, maintenance, and electrical (no financial cost to Stockton Unified School District)
- Despite efforts from Air District and CSC, Stockton Unified School District Board voted not to approve the license agreement to install air monitors at proposed locations
- Air District staff commenced work with CSC to identify alternative locations for air monitoring

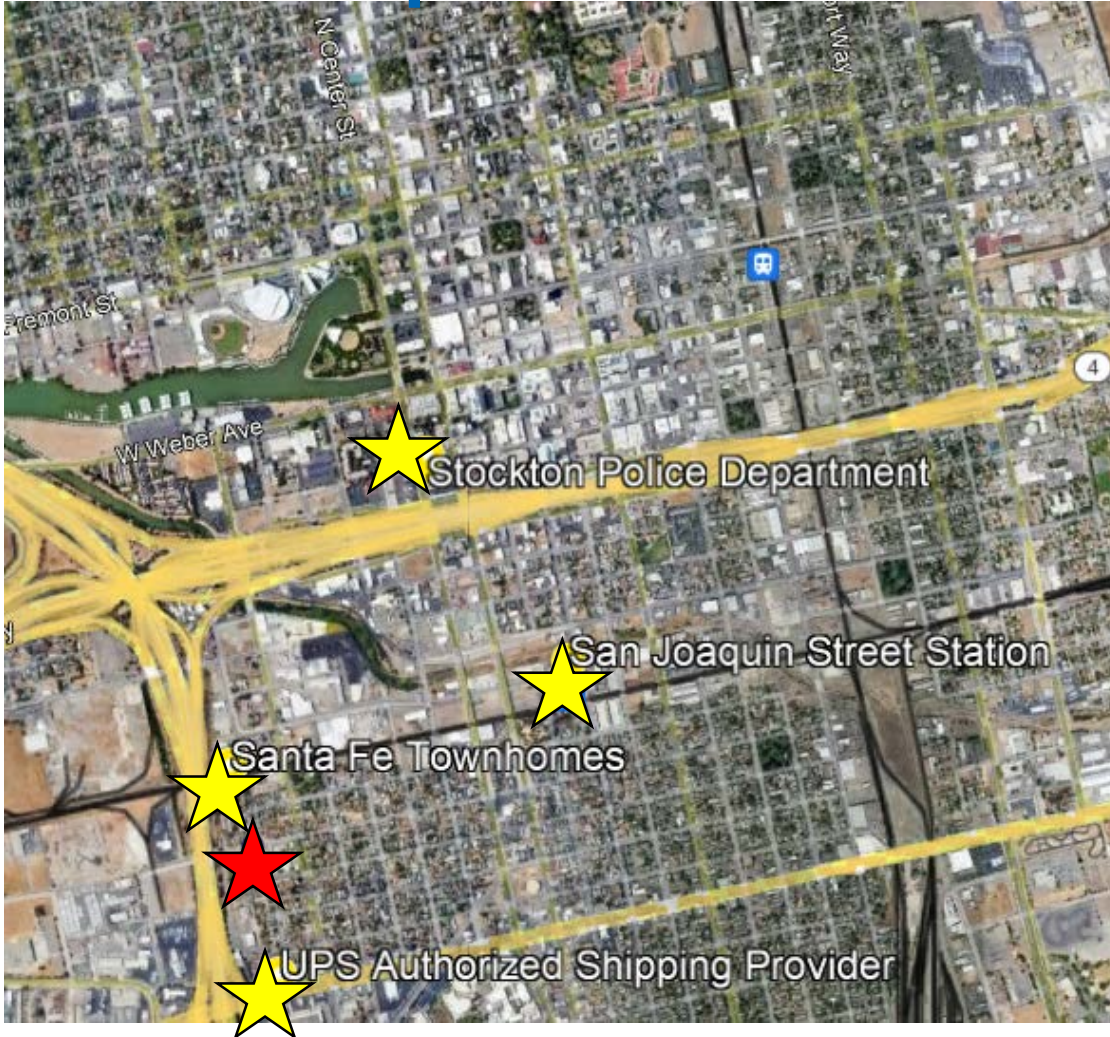

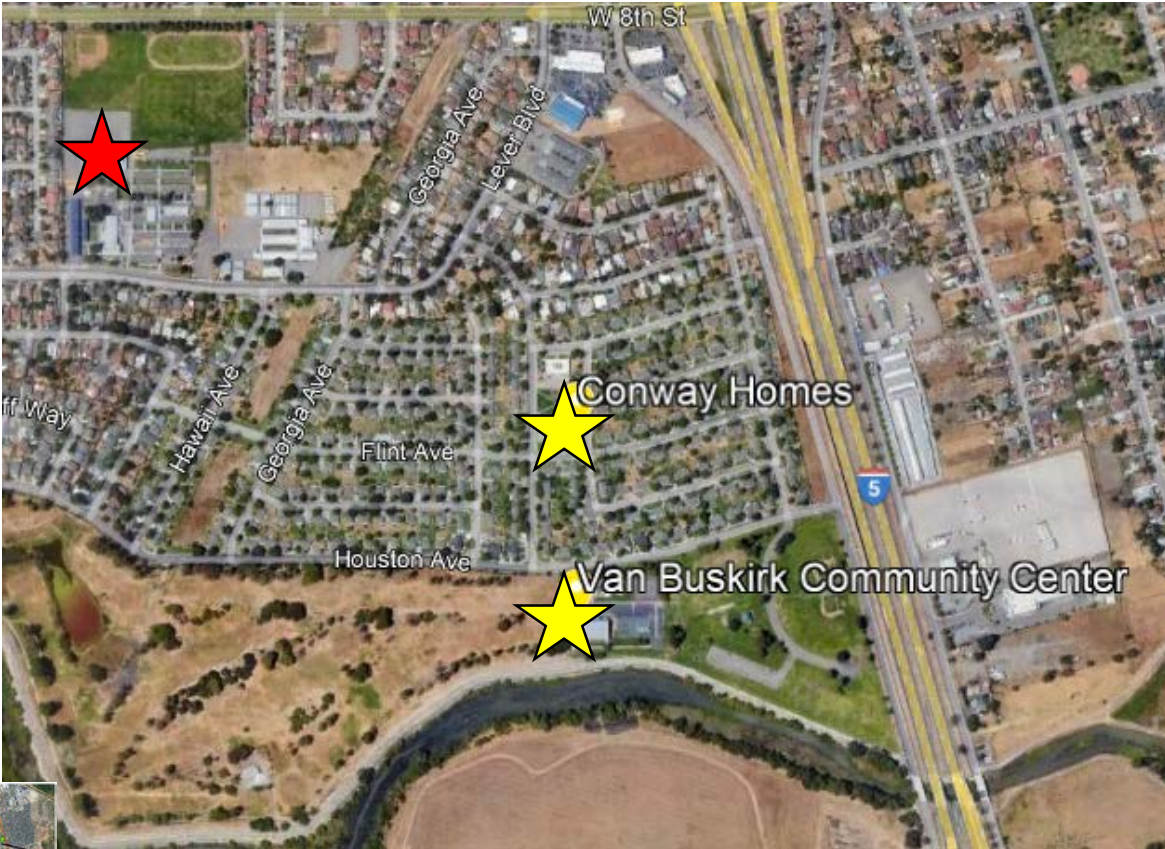

# Taft Elementary Alternative PM2.5 Monitor



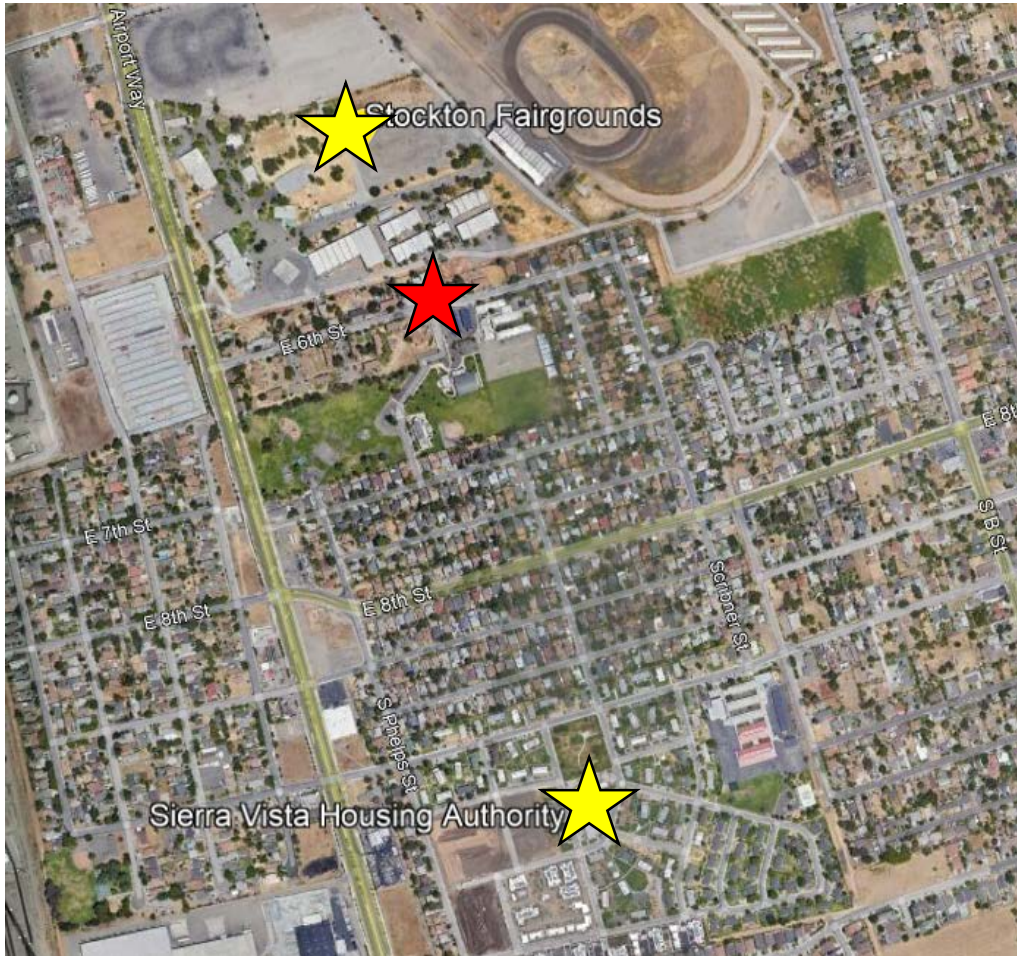
