Project Description: This measure will provide incentive funding for approved urban greening and vegetative barrier projects. Grants may be awarded to a city, county, special district (Green Improvements/Benefit District, Flood Control District, etc.), non-profit, tribal government, or public agency or entity for projects to be implemented within the Stockton community. The grant amount will cover 100 percent of eligible costs which includes an initial study, supplies/materials, construction, contracted services, and interpretative aids communicating information about the project.

Project Benefits: This strategy reduces greenhouse gas emissions and will provide multiple additional co-benefits like encouraging active transportation and reduced energy consumption due to shading. The District will use the established California Climate Investments quantification methodology for urban greening projects to calculate project level emission reductions from each completed project.
