



Arvin-Lamont Community Enforcement Update

Second Quarter 2026

Covering enforcement activities in the community from 4/1/2026 through 6/30/2026:

Fugitive Dust – District Regulation VIII

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort during the 2nd (April – June) and 3rd (July – September) quarters, which tend to be the driest times of the year and most likely to have issues with fugitive dust from earthmoving activities
- No public complaints received
- 3 violations of Regulation VIII observed

Statewide Anti-Idling Enforcement

- CERP commitment: One targeted enforcement effort every quarter
- 2 public complaint received
- No violations of CARB's truck and bus regulation observed

Stationary Source Inspections

- CERP commitment: Increased inspection frequency at facilities with emission violations in the last 3 years
- 29 total stationary source inspections (24 compliance inspections, 5 source test observations)

Enforcement Action Summary

- Stationary Source: 5 violation notices issued (emissions related)
- Non-stationary Source: 3 violation notices issued (2 emissions related, 1 procedural/administrative)

Public Complaints

- 26 total public complaints responded to in the community
 - 1 agricultural burn
 - 1 open burn
 - 2 diesel idling
 - 8 odor
 - 14 other
- No violation notices issued
