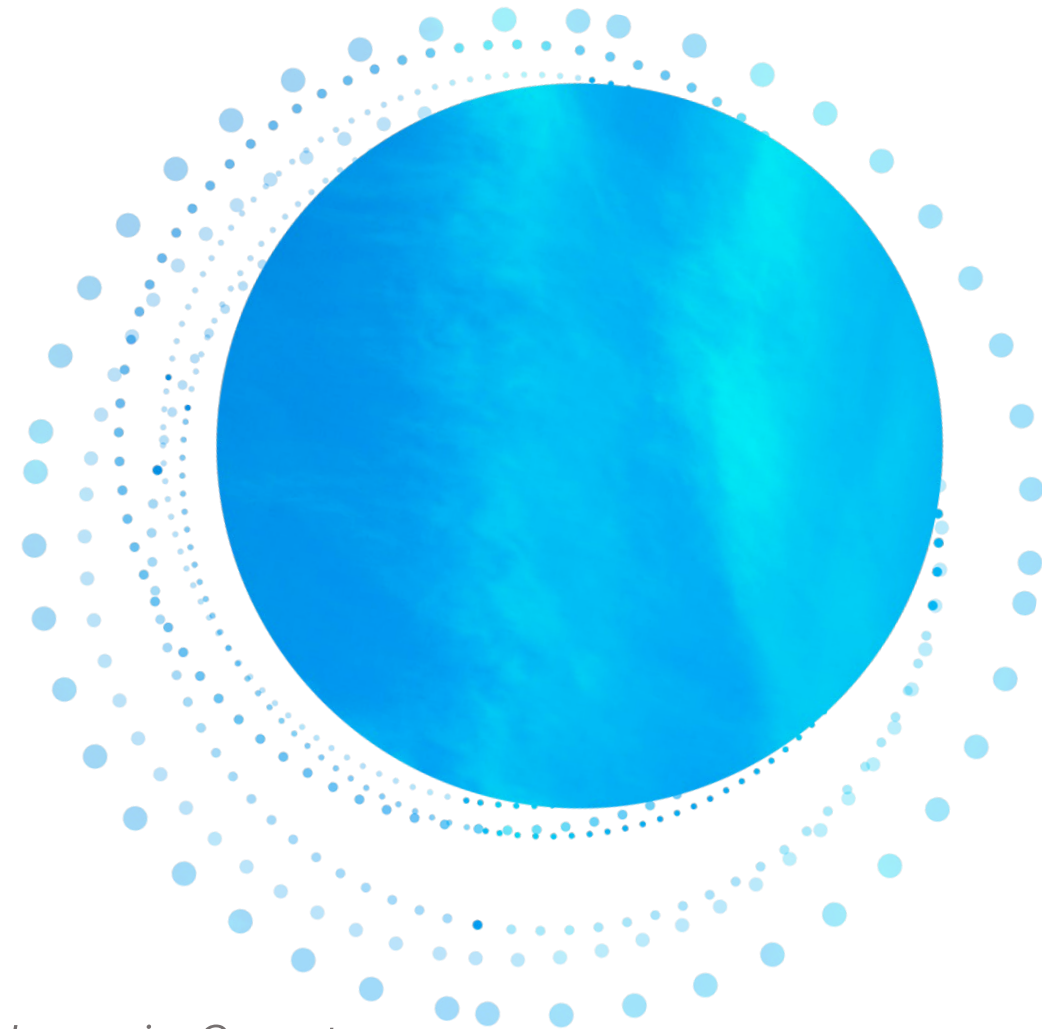

Our mission is to improve opportunities for people in need through energy efficiency, health, and education.

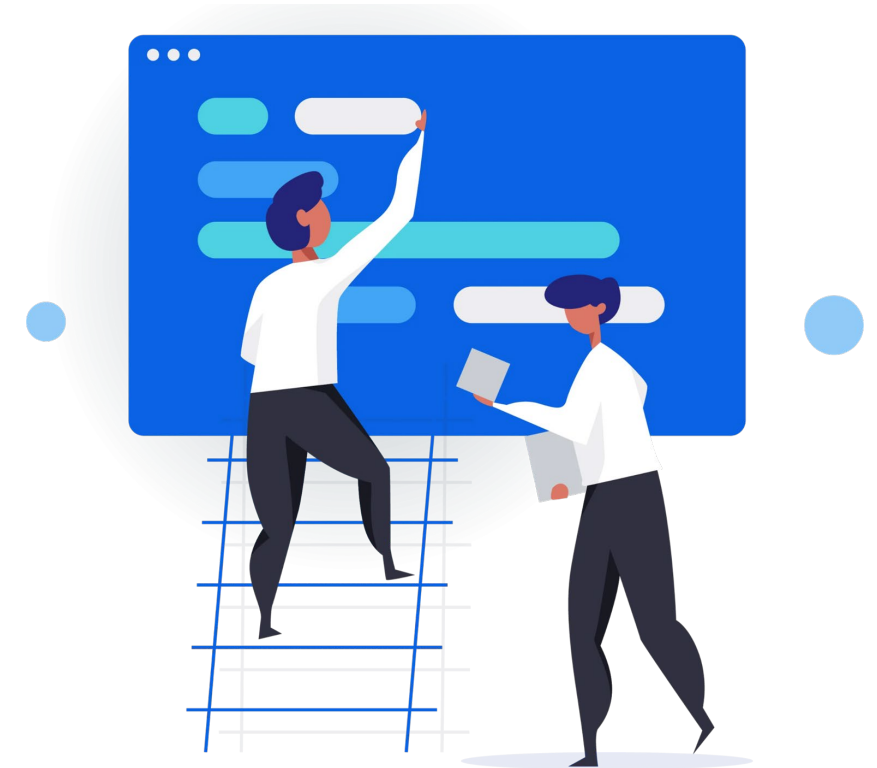
*We envision healthy and economically stable communities,

OUR SERVICES

CRP provides home energy upgrades and weatherization services in San Joaquin County through federal and state grants like the Department of Energy's Weatherization Assistance Program and the Low-Income Household Energy Assistance Program.

- HVAC (heating and cooling) repair or replacement
- Window and sliding door repair or replacement
- Repair or replacement of major appliances like the refrigerator, stove, and water heater
- Insulation of walls, ceilings, floors, and attics
- Weatherstripping and caulking to seal the home from the weather
- Installation of low-flow shower heads
- Replacement of energy inefficient lights and lightbulbs
- Solar panels (agricultural worker homeowners only)
- And many more!

Power Saver Rewards & Flex Alert



What Is Power Saver Rewards?

- Power Saver Rewards gives you **BILL CREDITS** when you reduce energy use during a Flex Alert.
- During a Flex Alert, use energy before 4:00 p.m. or after 9:00* p.m. to help prevent strain on the electric grid and get rewarded!
- There is no penalty if you don't reduce energy use, and there are no penalties for not signing up.
- Millions of people have already earned bill credits!

*Flex Alerts are commonly issued from 4:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. but may be issued outside of those hours.



What Is A Flex Alert?

A Flex Alert is a call for Californians to voluntarily reduce energy use when there's not enough energy supply to match demand.



When do Flex Alerts Occur?

- Heatwaves or when the statewide electric grid may be unable to provide power to all areas of the state
- 4:00-9:00 p.m. (typically)



Why do Flex Alerts Occur?

- Clean, renewable energy is decreasing in late afternoon while demand for energy is elevated
- People arriving home from school/work
- More A/C use

Flex Alert Messaging

MAIN ACTIONS TO PROMOTE:

Before 4 PM



Pre-cool your home



Cover your windows



Use major appliances



Charge your electronic devices

During 4-9 PM



Turn off any unused lights



Set thermostat to 78 degrees or higher



Unplug unused devices



Delay using major appliances (laundry, dishwasher...)
