Only one rail manufacturer, Wabtec (Transitioned from GE) offers railroad locomotives in their sales portfolio. Tugboats are not available yet, and there are no mass marketed truck-tractor manufacturers at this time. We should probably turn away from Heavy Duty at this time.
