Study Purpose

The California Statewide Truck Parking Study aims to identify and prioritize existing truck parking shortages across the state, and develop strategies for providing safe places for truck drivers to park that are supportive of safe, efficient movement of goods and also reflective of local requirements, concerns, and goals.

Meeting Purpose

Data collected during this study indicate that disadvantaged communities have a disproportionate share of undesignated truck parking. Undesignated truck parking is that which occurs outside of truck stops, rest areas, and other designated parking facilities. The purpose of this meeting is to gather input on how undesignated truck parking may be affecting your community, and to explore solutions that are consistent with your community needs and goals. A range of potential solutions will be presented for discussion purposes. Your input will inform and influence recommendations and implementation actions in the Final Report for this study.
