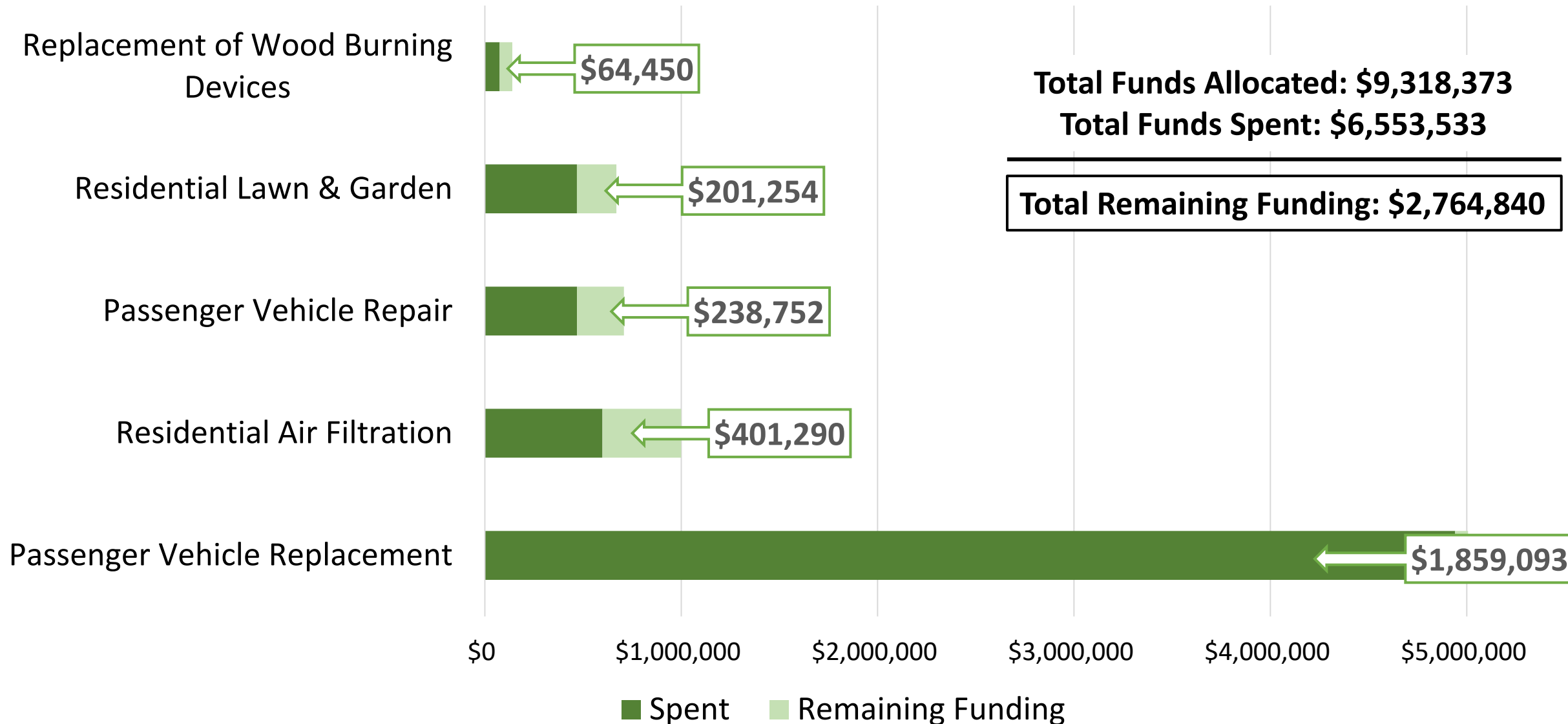

Remaining CERP Measures Implementation Progress



Fireplace & Woodstove Change-Out

- Funding in CERP: \$140,000 (28 units)
- Funding Remaining: \$64,450 (12 units)
- Gearing up for Fall/Winter outreach events where District will continue to distribute information
- Upcoming Winter Residential Woodsmoke Reduction Strategy campaign
 - Robust public education and outreach
 - Incentives to transition to cleaner alternatives



Passenger Vehicle Replacement Program

- Funding in CERP: \$6,800,000
- Funding Remaining: \$1.8M (up to 161 vehicles)
- Valley CAN will continue monthly, weeknight workshops until funding is exhausted
 - Next workshop is **September 28th** at Mountain Mikes (on Manthey Rd.)
- Residents can apply anytime outside of events!
 - ValleyCAN and District staff can support applicants through entire process via phone

Residential Lawn and Garden

- Funding in CERP: \$670,000
- Funding Remaining: \$201,254 (~400 units)
- District is currently promoting the program via social media (Facebook, Instagram, X) and at outreach events
- Working with ValleyCAN to plan next lawn mower exchange event



Passenger Vehicle Repair

- Funding in the CERP: \$708,393
- Funding Remaining: \$238,752 (~500 repairs)
- Residents are issued a voucher for \$500 in free emissions related repairs if vehicle fails an emissions test
- ValleyCAN and District staff support applicants through the process via phone

Clean Air Rooms Program

- Funding in CERP: \$1,000,000
- Funding Remaining: \$401,290 (1,861 units)
- District's Clean Air Rooms Program now offers up to **two FREE air purifiers per household** for residents living within the Stockton AB 617 community!

Back to School Outreach

- District conducted virtual outreach to all schools within the Stockton AB 617 boundary

- Schools were also provided information on how to refresh and utilize air quality tools and resources
