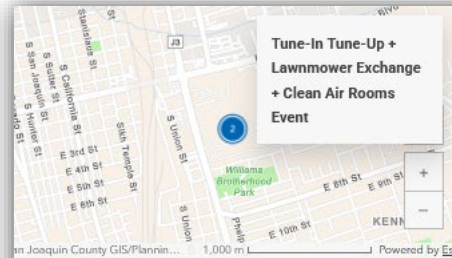
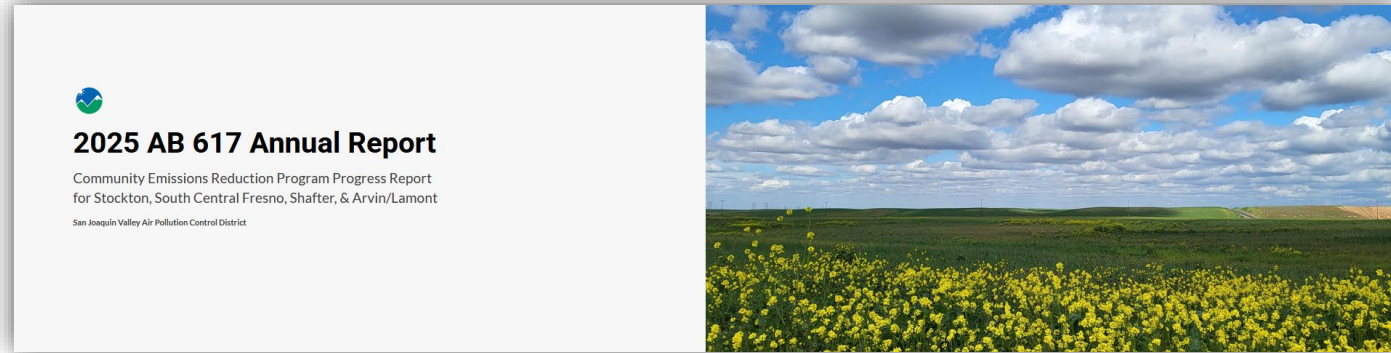

- The report was presented to the District's Governing Board on December 18



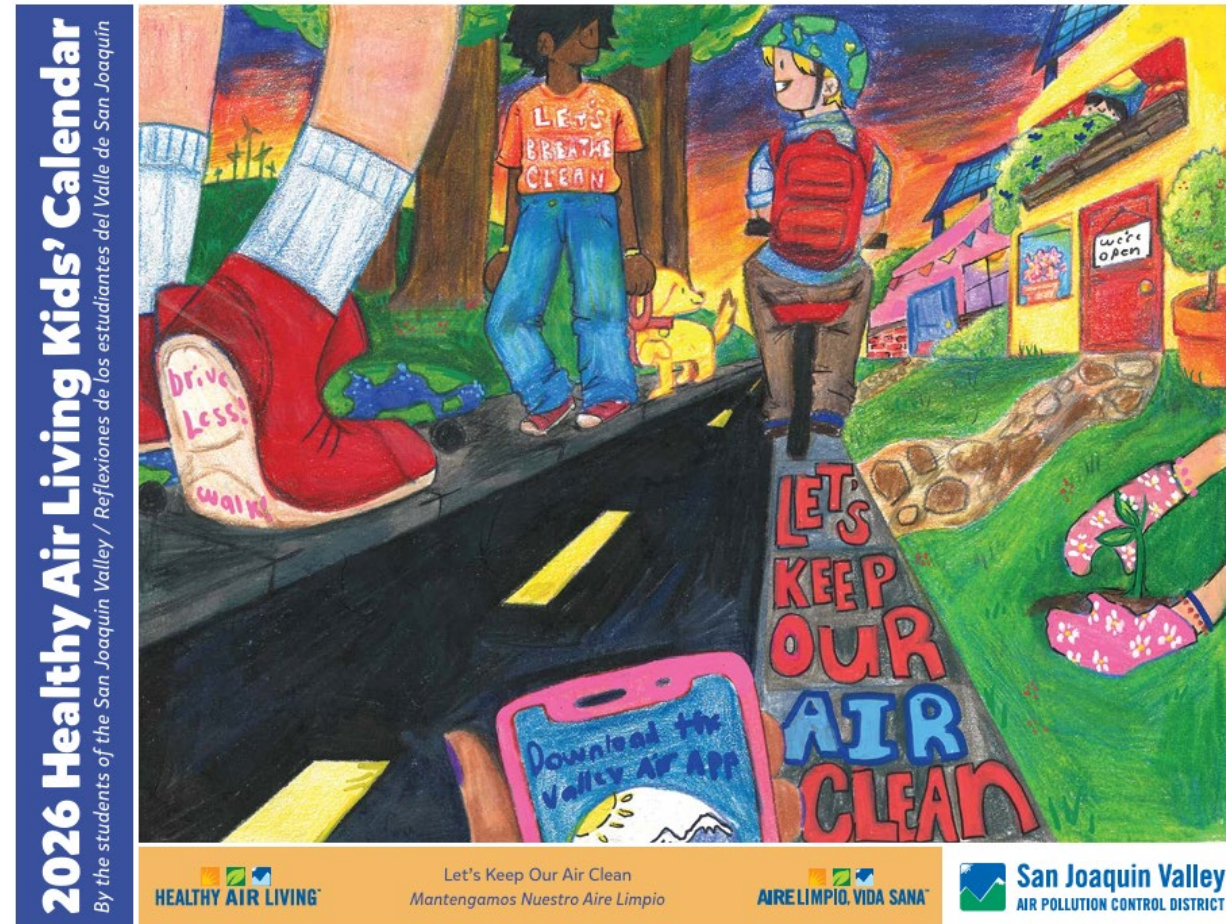
**2 Tune-In Tune-Up + Lawnmower Exchange + Clean Air Rooms Event**

On Saturday, June 28, Valley CAN, in partnership with the District, hosted a combined Tune-In Tune-Up + Lawnmower Trade-in Event at the San Joaquin County Fairgrounds. Thanks to strong community participation, 400 Stockton residents replaced their old, polluting gas-powered lawn mowers with new, electric mowers for free. The replacement of these 400 mowers helped reduce 0.52 tons of emissions (NOx, VOC and PM 10). In addition to exchanging

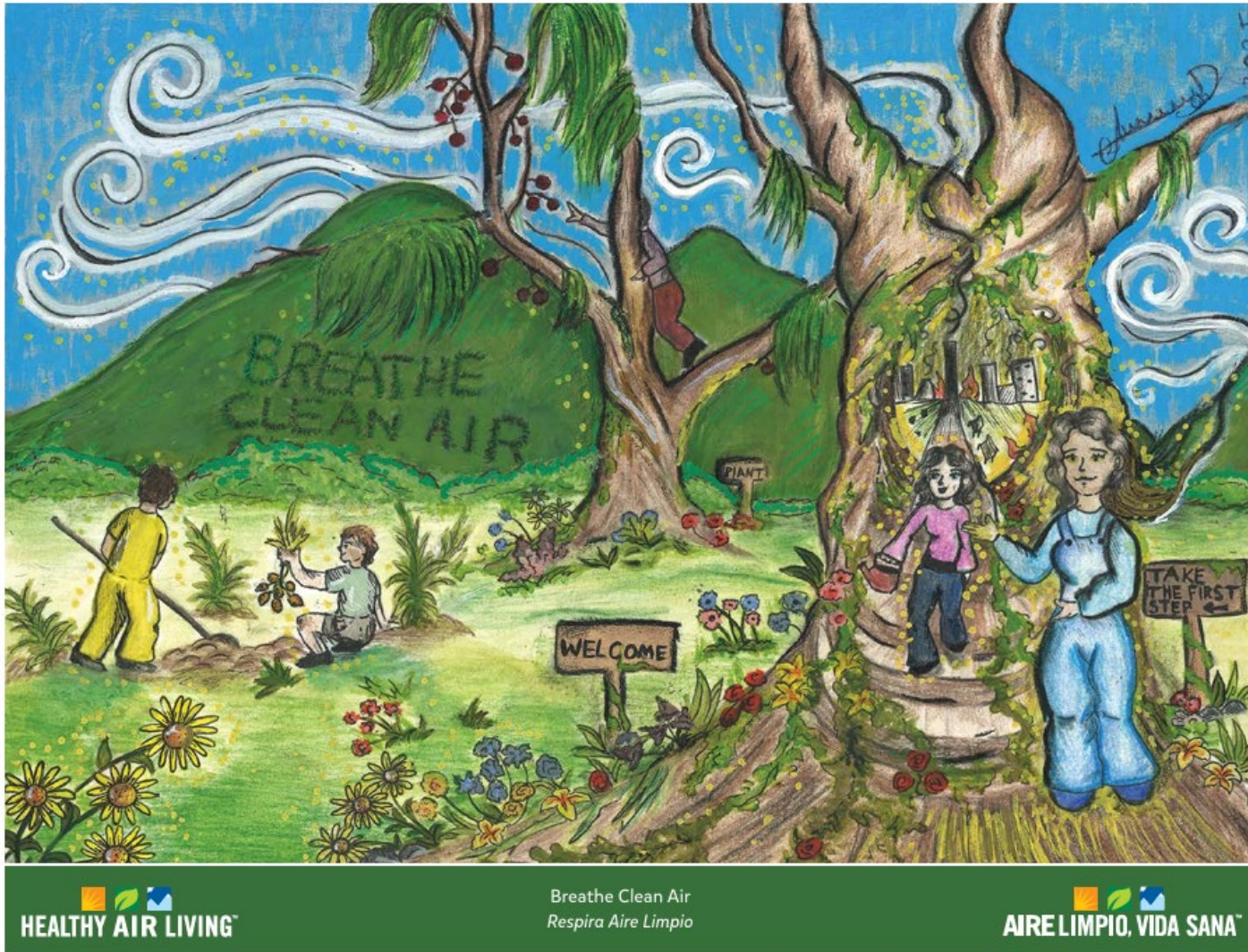


# 2026 Healthy Air Living Kids' Calendar

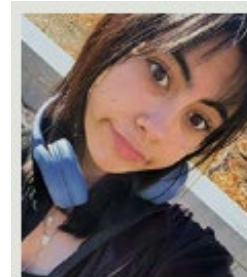
- 14 student artists from across the San Joaquin Valley

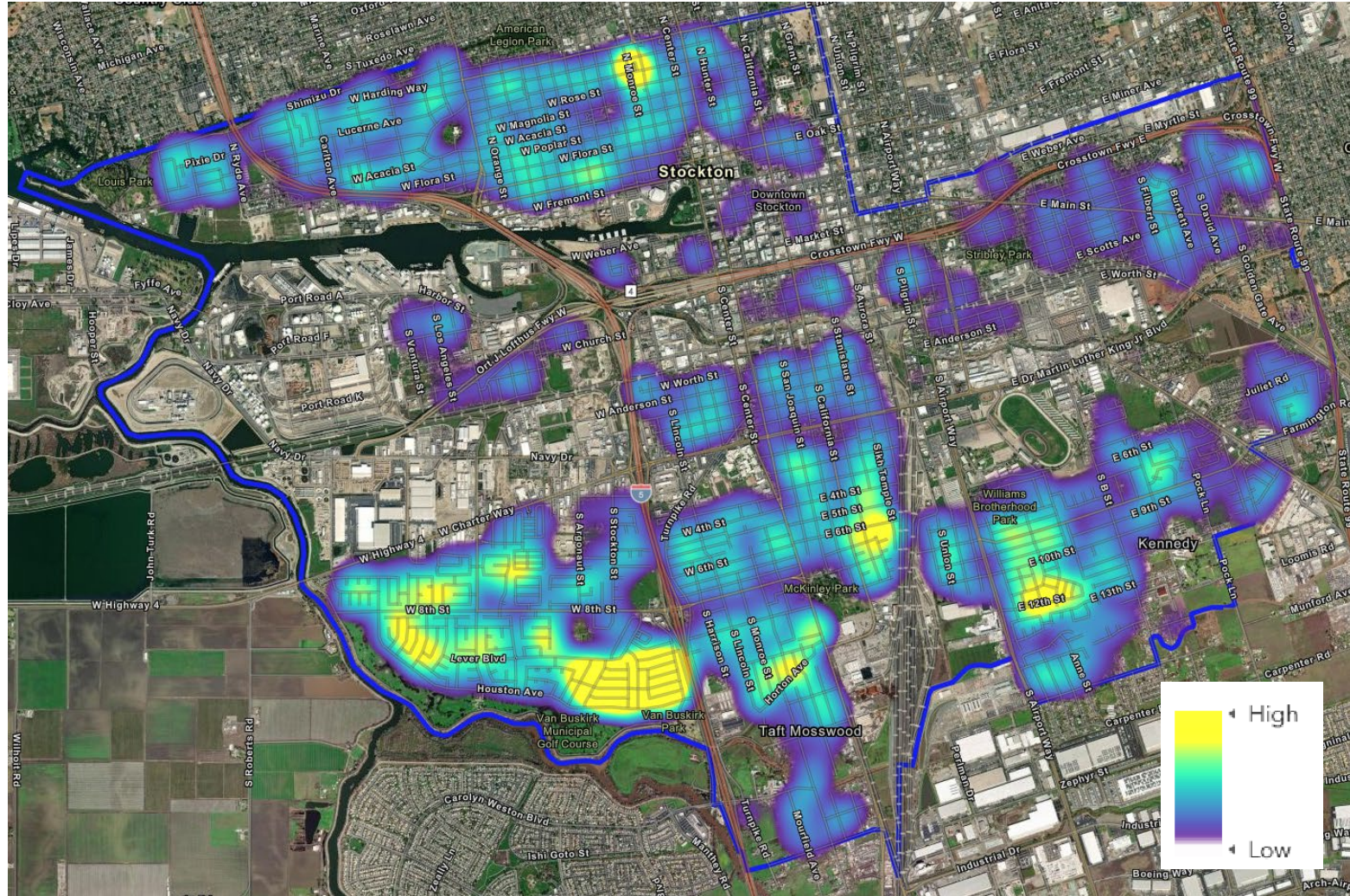
# 2026 Outreach Efforts

- **School & Youth Engagement**
  - Continue coordination with Stockton Unified and local charter/private/public schools
  - Classroom presentations/assemblies on air quality
  - Student Calendar Contest
  - Take-home materials
  - Digital flyers through Peach Jar
- **Health Focused Messaging**
  - Partner with Local clinics and Community partners
- **Social Media**

# Continued Clean Air Rooms Outreach

- District will expand outreach efforts to increase engagement in areas with lower participation
  - Community organizations can apply for a mini-grant to conduct outreach and promote participation
- District will update the CSC in the coming months to highlight progress made through ongoing outreach efforts



# Clean Air Room Outreach Update

- Last year, based on CSC feedback, District worked with an advertising agency to send a mailer to over 21,000 households within the AB617 boundary
  - Only sent to zip codes **fully** within the boundary
- District saw an increase in calls and assisted residents with applications via phone, email, and in-person
- **Additional mailer planned this year**

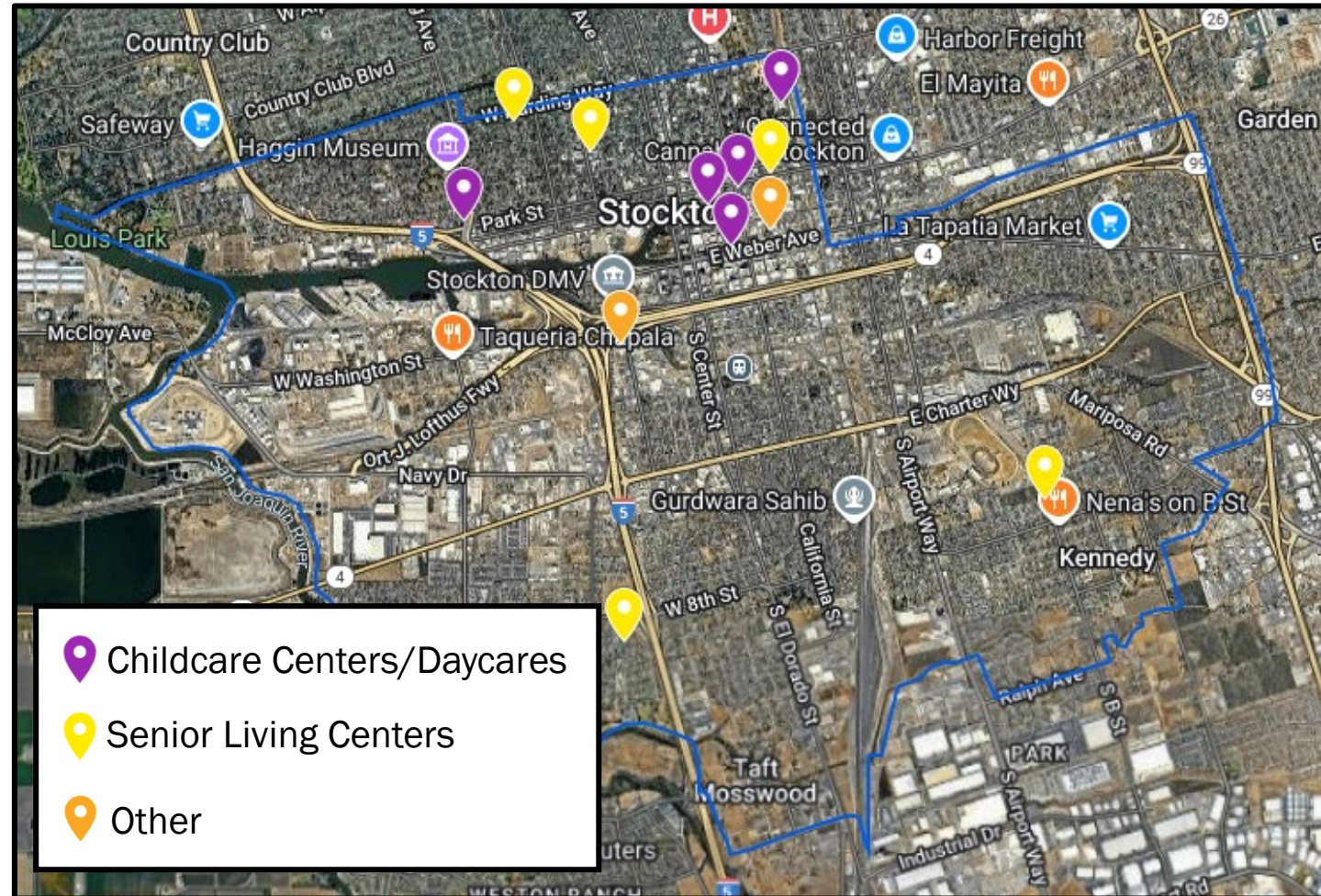

# Clean Air Rooms Program Expansion

- Clean Air Rooms expansion program will provide air purifiers to childcare centers, daycares, senior living centers and nursing homes
- District will start outreach in the Stockton AB 617 Boundary
  - Currently, 12 facilities on list
- If there are new suggestions, please let us know so we can add to our outreach list



# Passenger Vehicle Replacement

- **Funding Remaining: \$2,360,593.01**
- Valley CAN returned to hosting monthly weeknight workshops to assist interested applicants apply for the program
  - Assist interested residents through entire application process
  - Upcoming workshop January 26th at Mountain Mike's Pizza
- Outreach includes social media (Facebook, X, Instagram, NextDoor), radio ads, targeted digital ads
- Coordination with local community organizations, churches, and dealerships
- Coordinating transactions to ensure applicants get paid

# 2026 Lawn Mower Distribution Event

- **Funding Remaining: \$399,432**
- Funding allows for the replacement of about 800 mowers
- Grants team is working with Valley CAN to secure a date for 2026 distribution event
  - Once a date is secured, we will notify the CSC and Valley CAN will advertise on social media (Facebook)
