STATUS

In August, the CSC reviewed a set of projects and supported two proposals, **South A Street & South Derby Street**, that were within the \$6 million allocated for this measure. Since August's meeting, the City of Arvin and the District have been working together to ensure these projects bring needed emission reductions to the community. Based on this work, the City of Arvin has updated details about the projects to share with the CSC.

UPDATED PROJECTS



The City of Arvin has made the updates to the CSC's priority projects, including adding bike lanes, which help increase the emissions reduction potential from this measure.

- **South A Street:** Road resurfacing, improved sidewalk access.
- **South Derby Street:** New sidewalks, **ADDED bike lanes.**
- **ADDED Comanche Drive:** Based on the \$6M budget and updated engineering estimates, there is room for another CSC priority. This includes curb, gutter, and sidewalk installation along Comanche Drive.

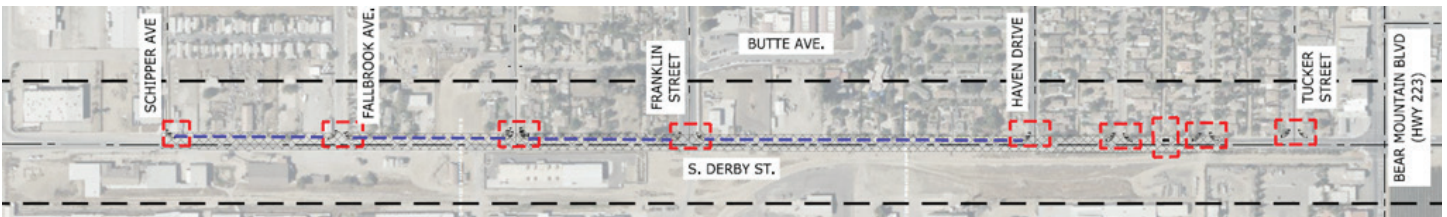

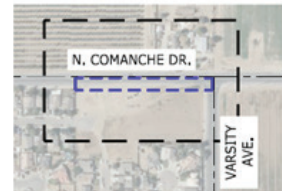
South A Street: Road resurfacing, improved sidewalk access.

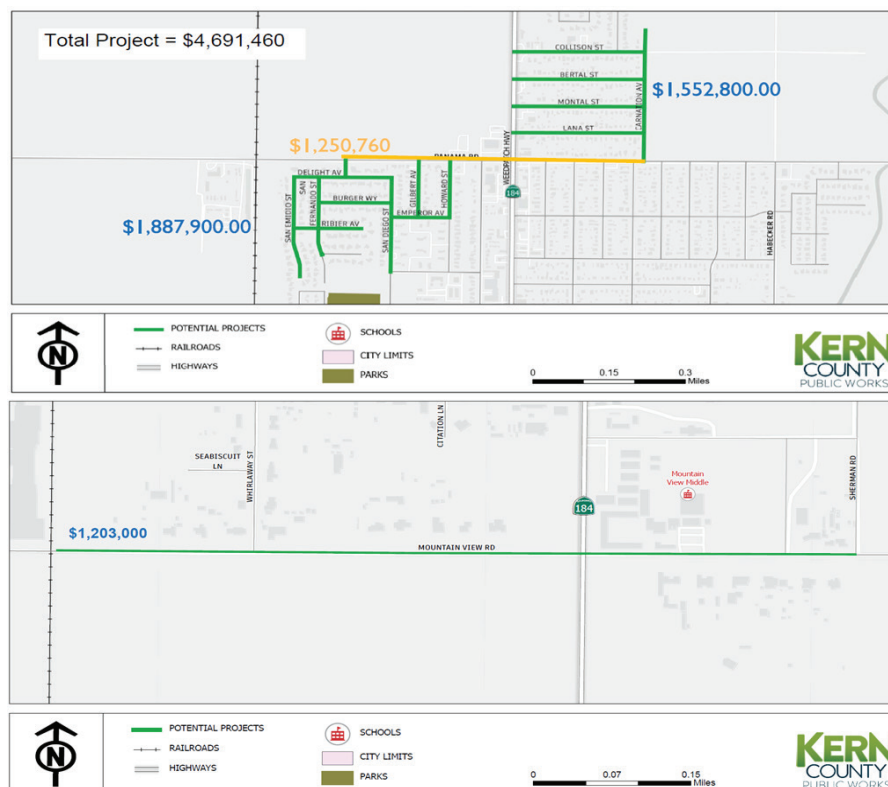
