Replace gas powered commercial lawn equipment with new electric options
**Public schools in AB 617 boundary eligible for free additional batteries and chargers*

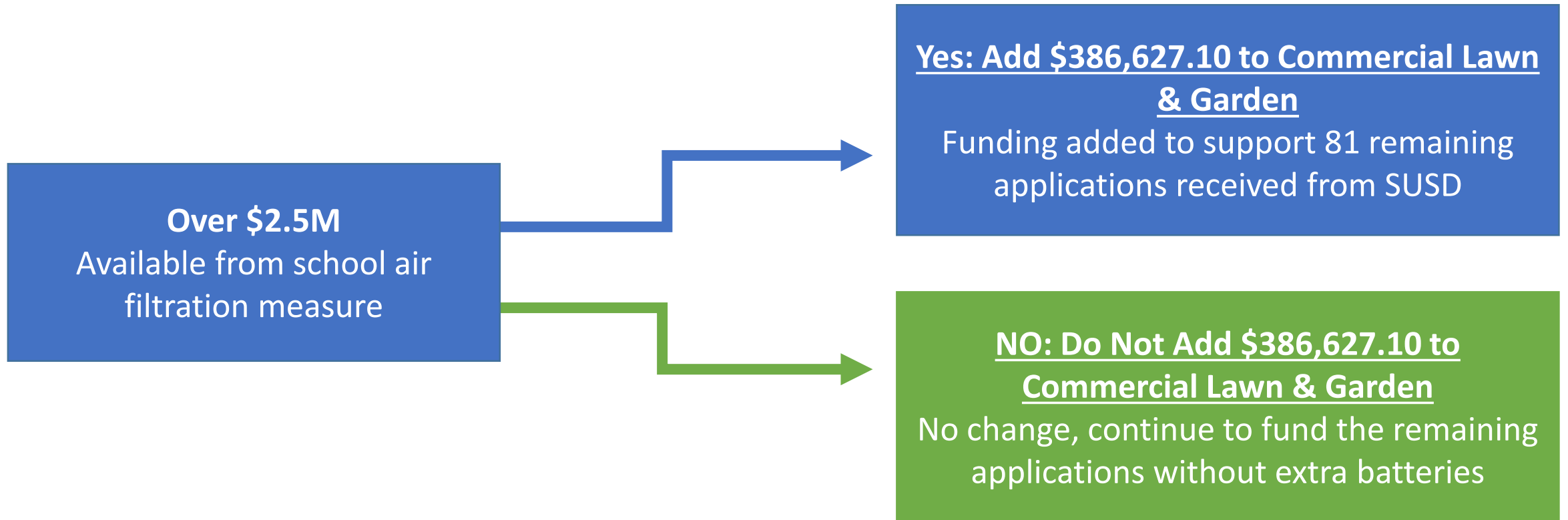
Funding in CERP

133 applications received

Remaining Funding
\$0

- District received **133** applications from Stockton Unified School District for new electric chainsaws, edgers, hedge trimmers, leaf blowers, pole saws, string trimmers and lawn mowers to reduce emissions at **27 different AB 617 schools within the community**
- District moved forward with **52** applications with available funding, **81 applications remaining due to funding in CERP**
- Opportunity for funding reallocation to support remaining applications

Over \$2M remaining for reallocation in other measures as necessary

Urban Greening & Vegetative Barriers Update

- LMR & Hyphae have taken feedback from Valley Air and subcommittee members to rescope project:
 - Removed vehicles & equipment from both projects: LMR is now able to leverage more flexible funds from TCC R.3 to purchase additional vehicles, trailers, and potentially other landscaping equipment as needed
 - Identified preliminary sites for Veg Buffs and continuing to map out additional sites to gather data on during project implementation:
 - Hazelton Elementary, MLK Blvd. [City ROW], and Caltrans specific site off Pershing exit)
 - Having introductory conversations with Public Works, SUSD, and Caltrans r.e: permits required, maintenance plans and agreements, procurement process
 - Rescoping project to subcontract Veg Buff and broader planting site preparation. Increased budget for landscape contracts:
 - Identifying local contractors for initial bids on veg barriers and concrete removal to gauge accuracy of budget.

Car Share Update

Contract executed with San Joaquin Housing Authority, partnering with Green Commuter and Míocar to implement program

8 vehicles plus DC fast chargers & Level II chargers

Car share programs established at **Sierra Vista & Crossway Residences** in AB 617 Boundary
