When filing an air pollution complaint, please include:

- A detailed description and exact location
- The type of issue (e.g., odor, burn, dust, smoke) and source if known
- If the activity is currently happening

- Si la actividad está ocurriendo en este momento

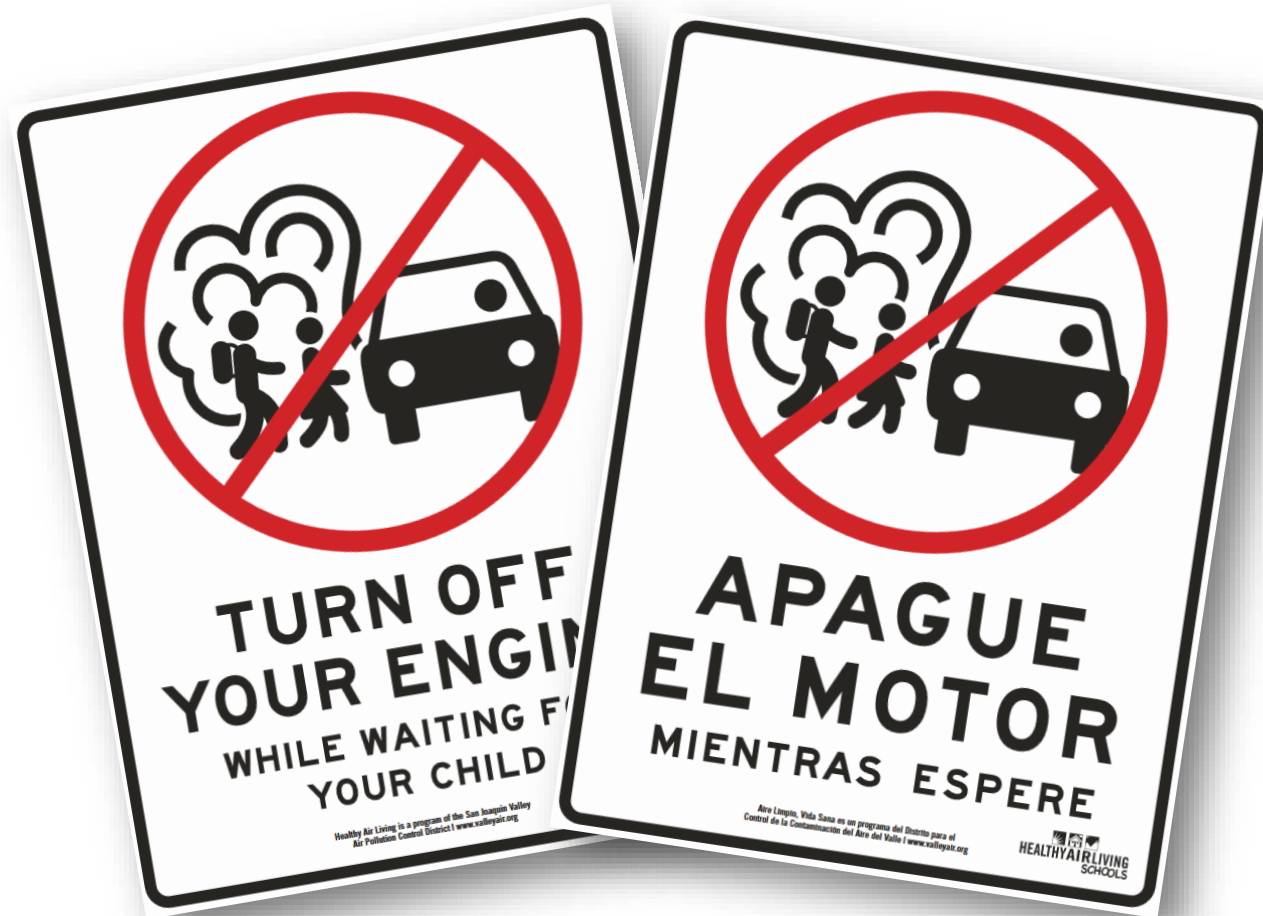

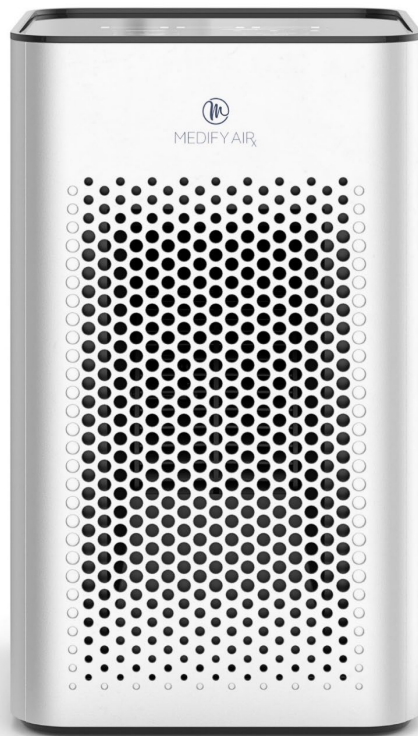

General Tips


Charge Up, Drive On

Don't leave your car plugged in all day. Move it once charging is complete so others can use the charger.




Know the Local Rules

In some states, it is illegal for a vehicle to be in a public EV charging space unless plugged in.




Be Loud

EVs are quiet, so be cautious, especially in residential areas and parking lots.



Find Charging Stations


Locate nearby charging stations at [plugshare.com](https://www.plugshare.com) or scan the QR Code.



Myths vs Facts about EVs


Myth: EVs are more expensive than gas-powered vehicles.

Fact: While EVs may have higher up-front costs, they can actually save you money long term when compared to gas-powered vehicles.




Myth: You can't go very far in an EV without having to charge it.

Fact: All-electric vehicles can typically go between 110 and over 300 miles on a single charge.




Myth: EV batteries have a short lifespan.

Fact: EV batteries can last 12-15 years in temperate climates and 8-12 in harsher climates. They are also covered under warranty for at least 8 years.




Myth: There are no EV charging stations in my area.

Fact: The number of charging stations is increasing as EVs gain popularity.



Myth: EVs only benefit those who can afford them.

Fact: EVs have no tailpipe emissions. They improve local air quality, which is good for everyone in our community.

Charge Up! Electric Vehicle Charger Incentive Program

Charge Up! Programa de Incentivos para Cargadores de Vehículos Eléctricos

- Provides funds to purchase and install electric vehicle chargers for public use. Measure supports the emission reductions associated with electric vehicle deployment.
- *Proporciona fondos para la compra e instalación de cargadores de vehículos eléctricos para uso público. Esta medida respalda la reducción de emisiones asociada con la adopción de vehículos eléctricos.*
- Who can apply?
 - Public agencies
 - Businesses
 - Property owners of multi-unit dwellings (i.e. apartment complexes, condominiums, etc.)

 - *Negocios*
 - *Propietarios de propiedades de viviendas multifamiliares (es decir, complejos de apartamentos, condominios, etc.)*
